STARBUCKS	THEFT BY SHOPLIFTING

On Monday, February 19, 2024, at approximately 0729 hours, I (Officer Johnson) responded to Starbucks (3820 N. Roosevelt Blvd.) in reference to a trespasser. The Starbucks is located in the 24 North Hotel. The call came from a third party not on scene (Manager Lily Brody). Upon arrival, I met with Starbuck`s employees. The employees stated that the suspect walked out towards the bathroom area.

I met with the suspect, later identified as Alleigha Church-Green. Alleigha Church-Green was standing in front of the bathroom door stating that she needed to use the restroom. The bathrooms are located outside of the Starbucks in the 24 North hotel. I allowed her to use the restroom and waited for her to come out. Alleigha Church-Green exited the bathroom. I told Alleigha Church-Green that I needed to talk to her to figure out what was going on. Alleigha Church-Green tried to walk away in the direction towards the hotel. I told her not to leave and grabbed her by the arm. Alleigha Church-Green pulled away and tried to get away. Alleigha Church-Green went limp and I took her to the ground and told her to put her hands behind her back. Alleigha Church-Green tensed up her arms and refused to put her hands behind her back. I had to force her arms behind her back in order to handcuff her. I searched Alleigha Church-Green and walked her to the back of my police car. I placed Alleigha Church-Green in the back of my police car. I had an officer stay with Alleigha Church-Green while went to Starbucks to get the whole story of what happened.

I met with Starbucks employee, Chrisna Joseph. Chrisna Joseph stated that the person we arrested identified as, Alleigha Church-Green, was causing a disturbance in the restaurant. Chrisna Joseph stated that Alleigha Church-Green was yelling and touching all of the food in the display case. Chrisna Joseph stated that Alleigha Church-Green tried to take other customers mobile orders sitting on the counter and the Starbucks employees had to take it away from her. Chrisna Joseph states that Alleigha Church-Green said she didn`t have any money. Chrisna Joseph stated that Alleigha Church-Green opened a protein shake (Koia Vanilla Bean) and never paid for it. Chrisna Joseph stated that Alleigha Church-Green actions disturbed all of the employees. Chrisna Joseph did not know if any customers were disturbed by the conduct. No customers came forward to report the incident.

There was an opened Koia Vanilla Bean drink that was left open on one of the tables. The dranked appeared to be partially consumed. The drink was never paid for. Starbuck`s provided receipts for the partially consumed Koia Vanila Bean drink (\$5.64) and one of the mobile orders that they had to take away from Alleigha Church-Green. The mobile order was 1 grande brown sugar oatmilt espresso with vanilla sweet topping (\$8.20). Total amount of stolen items \$13.84. The mobile order drink was recovered by Starbucks before it was consumed. The vanilla bean drink could not be recovered because it was partially consumed.

I went back to Police car to meet with Alleigha Church-Green to identify her and get her side of the story. Officer Howell stated that when he opened Alleigha Church-Green`s door she tried to escape. Officer Howell stated that Alleigha Church-Green resisted and he had to taser her to get her back into the police car. See officer Howells Supplemental. Officer Howell eventually got Alleigha Church-Green back into the police car. I asked Alleigha Church-Green to identify herself. Alleigha Church-Green provided part of her identity but refused to give all information needed for identification. Alleigha Church-Green refused to give her date of birth. I told Alleigha Church-Green that if she continued to refuse to give her identity, she would be given another charge. Alleigha Church-Green continued to refuse to identify herself.

Alleigha Church-Green did not appear to be in a normal state of mind. Alleigha Church-Green may have been under the influence of narcotics, alcohol, or having a mental illness episode. Alleigha Church-Green was making

statements not related to the questions asked of her and would talk about unrelated issues.

Sgt. Sims was notified of the response to resistance incident. I transported Alleigha Church-Green to the jail and Sgt Sims met us there. While in the jail, Alleigha Church-Green complained of a broken tooth and blood coming from her lip. Alleigha Church-Green refused to allow me to photograph the alleged injuries. I could not see any blood or evidence of a broken tooth.

The incident was recorded on my BWC. Starbucks employee statements were recorded on my BWC.

Charges:

1 Count of disorderly conduct in a licensed establishment. FSS. 877.03

The defendant, Alleigha Church-Green, did commit such acts of a nature to outrage the sense of public decency, effect the peace and quiet of those who witness them, and engage in such conduct as to constitute a breach of peace or disorderly conduct. This occurred on the premises of a licensed establishment (Starbucks).

1 Count Theft (Shoplifting). 812.014 (3A)

The defendant, Alleigha Church-Green, did knowingly obtain the property of another with intent to either permanently or temporarily deprive the business (Starbucks) of a right to the property or benefit from the property. The property was valued at \$13.84.

3 Counts: Resisting and officer without violence FSS. 843.02

The defendant did resist, obstruct and oppose a police officer while in the lawful execution of legal duties without offering or doing violence to the officers. All officer were dressed in their Class B uniforms.

Count 1:

Alleigha Church-Green tried to get away from officer Johnson and refused to put her hands behind her back at the beginning of the investigation.

Count 2:

Alleigha Church-Green attempted to get away from Officer Howell and refused to get back into the police car. (See Officer Howells Supplemental report)

Count 3:

Alleigha Church-Green refused to fully identify herself after multiple requests to do so.

I returned to Starbucks after I cleared from the jail to get a sworn written statement from Chrisna Joseph. Chrisna Joseph provided a sworn written statement.

On Monday, 02/19/2024 at approximately 0729 hours, Probationary Ofc. Roman and I (Ofc. Howell) self-initiated back up for Ofc. Johnson at 3820 North Roosevelt Boulevard (Starbucks Coffee) regarding a unknown black female subject potentially trespassing.

Probationary Ofc. Roman and I immediately encountered Ofc. Johnson attempting to handcuff an unknown black female subject. The unknown black female subject was actively attempting to pull away and refusing to be handcuffed. As we approached, I witnessed Ofc. Johnson place the unknown black female subject on the ground in a very controlled manner. The unknown black female subject then attempted to stand up several times and continuously pulled her hands and forearms under her torso, refusing to be handcuffed. I instructed Probationary Ofc. Roman to "grab her feet" in an effort to restrict the unknown black female subject's ability to potentially kick at all officers on scene. I restricted the movement of her right hand and forearm. Ofc. Johnson and I were eventually able to pull her hands and forearms free, place them on the small of her back, and place her in handcuffs. Ofc. Johnson and I searched the unknown black female subject subsequent to arrest. Ofc. Johnson and I walked the unknown black female subject to Ofc. Johnson's patrol vehicle. Ofc. Johnson and I placed the unknown black female subject in the rear seat of Ofc. Johnson's patrol vehicle. Ofc. Tellier and Probationary Ofc. Roman searched the unknown black female subject's belongings.

Ofc. Johnson continued his investigation, speaking with the reporting party and potential witnesses. I remained near Ofc. Johnson's patrol vehicle to keep the arrestee under observation. During Ofc. Johnson's investigation, we realized that the unknown black female subject did not have a form of identification on her person or within her belongings.

I open the rear door of Ofc. Johnson's patrol vehicle, in an attempt to speak with the arrestee and determine her identity. The unknown black female subject immediately turned toward me and placed her feet outside of the vehicle, screaming "I can not breath, I just need fresh air." I instructed the unknown black female to place her feet back in the vehicle, several times. She ignored me and attempted to push past me. The unknown black female subject attempted to run between me and the door of the patrol vehicle. Due to the unknown black female subject actions, continuous aggression, and level of resistance rising I performed a modified leg sweep and placed the unknown black female subject on the ground in a somewhat controlled manner. She fell "face-first" within a small bush near the front of the parking area. The unknown black female subject immediately rolled over, placed her back on the ground, and attempted to stand up. Probationary Ofc. Roman and I lifted the unknown black female subject up and attempted to place her back in the rear seat of Ofc. Johnson's patrol vehicle. Probationary Ofc. Roman and I stood the unknown black female subject near the rear passenger-side door, while I opened the rear door again. She immediately went "limp" and dropped to the ground near the rear passenger-side tire. The unknown black female subject then attempted to wrap her legs around the passenger-side tire. Probationary Ofc. Roman and I were eventually able to move the

Due to the unknown black female subject actions, continuous aggression, and level of resistance rising I placed the taser on the unknown female black female subject`s left shoulder blade and drive stun her. She immediately complied, stood up, and sat in the rear seat of Ofc. Johnson`s patrol vehicle.

The unknown black female subject had no visible injuries.

Ofc. Johnson transported the unknown black female subject to Monroe County Detention Center. Probationary Ofc. Roman and I followed Ofc. Johnson to the Monroe County Detention Center to assist with removing her from Ofc. Johnson`s patrol vehicle.
