On April 08th 2019 at 2041 hrs. I (Officer Tyler) was dispatched to a Hit and Run crash with injury at the intersection of Palm Avenue and Roosevelt Blvd. A black Chevrolet pickup truck bearing Florida license plate # CZPG43 crossed the center line on Palm Ave and sideswiped a brown mini cooper bearing Florida license plate # IGLB72. A witness named Kevin Rowland saw the crash happen and followed the black truck. The driver of the Mini Cooper convertible, Sherri Keller who was identified by her Alaska drivers license # 7413524 was struck in the face by her cars mirror and had bruising on her left arm. Keller was transported to Lower Keys Medical Center by EMS.

Rowland followed the black truck down First Street then onto Flagler Avenue and finally the truck stopped moving at the intersection of Thompson and Von Phister Street's. I went to the intersection of Thompson and Von Phister while other units responded to the crash scene on Palm Ave. Upon arrival, I contacted Ofc. Waite and Ofc. Morris who were already on scene. The witness Rowland was parked behind the truck and filled out a witness statement. I sent Ofc. Morris to Palm Avenue to work the crash while I stayed with the driver of the truck.

The black Chevy Silverado bearing Florida license plate # CZPG43 was stopped in the middle of the road on Thompson street. The truck had extensive front end damage to the driver's side. The driver's side front tire was shredded off the rim and the truck was not running. The driver of the truck, Armin Rostran, who was identified by his Florida driver's license # R236005923790, did not remember crashing into anything and was sitting on the grass next to the truck on the side of Thompson street. The passenger of the truck, Gina Mastrapa, was identified by her Florida driver's license # M236280945530, who also did not remember crashing into anything and was highly intoxicated. Mastrapa was sitting on the grass on Thompson street on the passenger side of the truck.

I asked Rostran and Mastrapa for their driver's licenses. Mastrapa handed me her license. Rostran said his license was in the truck. Mastrapa and Rostran had a conversation about where his license was. I wrote down Rostran's information and ran them both through F/NCIC. When I returned from my car I asked Rostran if he knew where his license was. Rostran replied in his wallet in his truck. I told Rostran he could get his wallet. I followed him to the truck. When he opened the door to get his wallet I observed a clear glass mason jar containing what appeared to be marijuana. The mason jar was sticking out from the under the front driver's seat in plain view. Next to the jar on the floor board was a black box that did not have a top on it. Inside that box were rolling papers. I placed Rostran into handcuffs and sat him back on the side of the road in the grass. I removed the mason jar from the truck and placed it onto the hood of the truck.

I contacted K9 Ofc. T Anglin to respond to the scene to assist me. Ofc. Anglin arrived on scene with Ofc. K9 Ben and conducted a K9 sniff of the pickup truck. Before Ofc. K9 Ben conducted a sniff of the truck, I removed the mason jar and placed it onto the front seat of Ofc. Anglin's patrol car. Ofc. K9 Ben had a positive alert to the truck. Ofc. Anglin and I conducted a search of the truck. Inside the glovebox of the truck Ofc. Anglin located another clear Mason Jar containing a green leafy substance of suspected marijuana. Sitting on the floor of the passenger side of the truck was a half gallon of Bacardi Rum Long Island ice tea and a 750 ml bottle of Bacardi Limon, both bottles were half empty and the seal on the bottles were broken.

Ofc. Anglin field tested the green leafy substance and it tested positive for marijuana. I mirandized Rostran and he said he did not want to answer my questions but did take responsibility for the marijuana (Without being questioned). I turned over all the evidence to Ofc. Anglin who transported it back to the Key West Police Station for packaging. The total weight of the marijuana was 26.1 grams. Ofc. Anglin packaged the property according to the policy of the Key West Police Department.

I placed Rostran under arrest and transported him to the Monroe County Detention Center. Rostran's pickup truck was driving was towed from the scene by Arnold's Towing. Ofc. Morris completed a traffic crash report in reference to the hit and run crash. After leaving the emergency room Ofc. Morris informed me Keller sustained bruising to her left eye, left cheek, left bicep and possible internal injury to her left rib cage.

I placed Rostran under arrest for F.S. 893.13-6A (5331) POSSESS MARIJUANA OVER 20 GRAMS, F.S. 893 147-1 POSSESS AND OR USE DRUG PARAPHERNALIA and F.S. 316.027-2A LEAVING THE SCENE OF A CRASH INVOLVING INJURY. Rostran was issued citation # AAMZOQE for F.S. 316.027-2A LEAVING THE SCENE OF A CRASH INVOLVING INJURY with a 9:00 am court date in front of Judge Fowler on April 25th, 2019. Rostran signed the citation and was turned over to the Monroe County Detention Center Deputies without incident. Rostran was also issued citation # AAMZORE for F.S. 316.1936-2A OPEN CONTAINER WHILE DRIVING.

My BWC was activated during the investigation.

On 07APR19 at 2105, I (Ofc. T. ANGLIN) responded to the intersection of Thompson Street and Von Phister Street, at the request of Ofc. B. TYLER, who was out with a black 2012 Chevrolet Silverado, (FL Tag# CZPG43) in connection with a hit and run with injuries. Upon my arrival to the scene, Ofc. B. TYLER informed me that he had recovered Marijuana and drug paraphernalia from inside the Chevrolet, (See original report) and he requested that I assist him in searching the vehicle further. Prior to our search, I elected to utilize K-9 BEN to conduct a sniff of the exterior of the Chevrolet.

I affixed my six-foot nylon lead onto K-9 BEN'S one-inch nylon collar and retrieved him from the rear of my patrol vehicle. I approached the passenger's side front bumper on the Chevrolet; I gave K-9 BEN the command to sniff for narcotics and moved counter clockwise around the exterior of vehicle.

I observed a noticeable change in K-9 BEN'S normal behavior as we approached the driver's door on the Chevrolet. K-9 BEN'S body became rigid and his respiratory effort increased as he scanned his nose along the front quarter panel toward the driver's door. K-9 BEN paused in front of the driver's door, took in several deep breaths and sat. I gave K-9 BEN his toy reward and secured him in the rear of my patrol vehicle.

Both Ofc. B. TYLER and I manually searched the interior of the Chevrolet. As I searched the passenger's side of the Chevrolet, I observed trace amounts of a green and brown leafy substance on the floorboards and inside the front passenger's door. I conducted a field test on the green and brown leafy substance and the result was F.T.P. Marijuana. I located a jar containing two small plastic bags; each containing several green and brown leafy clusters. I conducted a field test on a sample of the green and brown leafy substance and the result was F.T.P. Marijuana.

I observed trace amounts of a white powdery residue in the crevasses of the front passenger's seat cushion and the center jump seat cushion. I conducted a field test on the powdery residue using a Cocaine wipe and the result was F.T.P. Cocaine. I conducted a field test on a sample of the suspected Marijuana Ofc. B. TYLER recovered and the result was F.T.P. Marijuana.

I took possession of all the Marijuana and the drug paraphernalia, (Box containing Marijuana rolling papers); I gathered information for my report and departed the scene. I later packaged the items on behalf of Ofc. B. TYLER and submitted them into the KWPD Property and Evidence Section as evidence.

Both my Axon body worn camera and my Coban in car camera were active during this incident and later uploaded into their servers.

On April 8, 2019 I, Officer Waite, was dispatched to the corner of Von Phister and Thompson Street in reference to a hit and run. Dispatch advised that a witness had followed the suspect vehicle to this location. I arrived behind Officer Morris, who had the driver, later identified as Armin Rostran, seated on the side of the street. The vehicle, a black Chevrolet Silverado, had severe damage to the driver side quarter panel. A female, later identified as Gina Mastrapa, was asleep in the front passenger seat. Concerned for Mastrapa's welfare, I opened the door to check on her. I shook Mastrapa's arm and asked her if she was okay. Mastrapa advised that she was okay and continued to sleep. I requested that dispatch send Rescue to evaluate Mastrapa. Mastrapa heard my request and sat up in her seat. I explained to Mastrapa that she was involved in an accident, and she stated that she was not injured. Mastrapa was unaware that the accident took place. I could smell the odor of an alcoholic beverage emanating from her breath as she spoke. Mastrapa's eyes appeared red and glassy.

I watched over Mastrapa and Rostran as Traffic Officer Tyler and K-9 Officer Anglin investigated the crash. Once the investigation was complete Officer Tyler placed Rostran under arrest. Ofc. Tyler requested Arnold's Towing for the Silverado and asked that I stand by with the vehicle and complete a tow slip.

While I was waiting for Arnold's Towing, Mastrapa asked me how she was supposed to get home. I advised Mastrapa to call a friend or family member. Mastrapa accused me of not caring for her well being. Mastrapa asked how I could leave an attractive woman, such as herself, on the street and so far away from her home in Miami. Mastrapa stated that she could be raped or become the victim of human trafficking if left alone. Again, I suggested that Mastrapa call a friend or family member. Mastrapa asked me if I could refrain from towing the vehicle and allow her to drive the vehicle back home despite its inoperable condition. Mastrapa made phone calls. As she spoke on the phone, her voice grew louder and residents came out of their homes. I suggested that Mastrapa leave the neighborhood before a resident accuses her of disturbing the peace which could result in arrest. Mastrapa advised that she was on public property and told me that she was not required to leave. Mastrapa eventually spoke to a friend that was willing to make the trip from Miami to Key West. Mastrapa handed her phone to me and I spoke with the friend. I asked the friend to explain to Mastrapa that she was in a residential neighborhood. I also suggested that the friend try to convince Mastrapa to walk to a landmark such as a Publix or a Gas Station. The friend stated that she would start traveling down the Keys to retrieve Mastrapa. I handed Mastrapa her phone, moments later she argued with the friend and hung up on her.

Due to Mastrapa's intoxication, I was concerned for her well being. Her friend was approximately 3 hours away and she did not appear as though she could care for herself. I called Sgt Siracuse and advised him that Mastrapa appeared to be intoxicated. I explained to him that Mastrapa was refusing to leave the neighborhood and I was concerned that the Key West Police Department would continue to get calls regarding Mastrapa if left alone. Due to Mastrapa's intoxication and lack of ability to make rational decisions I decided to take her into protective custody under the Marchman

I approached Mastrapa and advised her to place her hands behind her back. Mastrapa screamed "No my friend is coming to get me". I explained to Mastrapa that her friend was approximately 3 hours away. I explained to Mastrapa that I was not comfortable leaving her alone as she was intoxicated. Mastrapa told me that she was not intoxicated and advised that her friend was only 30 minutes away. I stated to Mastrapa "do not to fight me" and order her to place her hands behind her back. Mastrapa refused, however, I was able to get one hand cuff on Mastrapa's right wrist before she pulled away from me. As Mastrapa would not comply with my verbal commands and continued to resist arrest, I conducted an arm bar take down. On the ground, Mastrapa placed her left hand underneath her body in an attempt to prevent me handcuffing her. Mastrapa struck me in the chest with her elbow twice as I attempted to free her hand. I was able to free Mastrapa's hand by applying pressure to her waist area using my knee. Once handcuffed I placed Mastrapa into my vehicle and requested a supervisor. When my supervisors arrived, they walked over to my vehicle to observe Mastrapa. Mastrapa advised that she felt constrained and was having trouble breathing so I requested Rescue. Key West Rescue 1 arrived and decided to transport Mastrapa to Lower Keys Medical Center as she appeared to be hyperventilating.

I boarded the ambulance to assist Rescue 1 with Mastrapa as she was extremely combative. Mastrapa scratched EMT Michael Anderson's hand as he attempted to belt her into the gurney. Mastrapa would pulsate her body as if having a seizure every time Rescue would attempt to treat her. Rescue advised that Mastrapa was not seizing. Rescue offered Mastrapa oxygen as she appeared to be having trouble breathing. Mastrapa refused.

Lower Keys Medical Center cleared Mastrapa. I then transported Mastrapa to the Monroe County Detention Center (MCDC). While enroute to MCDC Mastrapa asked that I not charge her with resisting as she did not want a duplicate charge on her record. Mastrapa advised that she was charged with resisting an officer in 2014 and was attempting to have the charge removed from her record.

Mastrapa was booked into MCDC and charged with "resisting officer with violence to his or her person". Mastrapa did resist me as I attempted to take her into protective custody. Mastrapa did elbow me in the chest twice as I attempted to hand cuff her.

My BWC was activated throughout this call and will be uploaded into evidence. Photographs of Mastrapa will also be uploaded into evidence.
