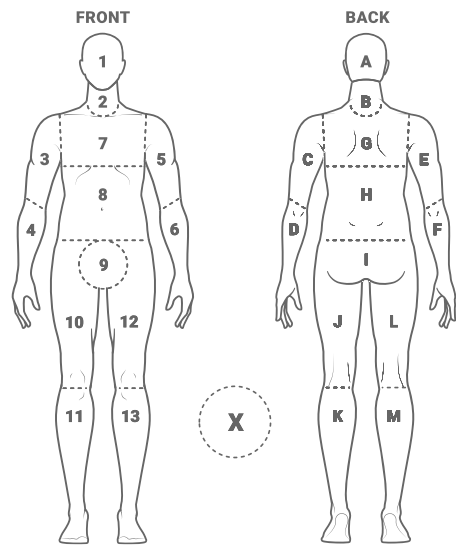

EXPLANATION OF RESISTANCE LEVEL Lehmkuhle was asked by Bull & Whistle staff to leave the premises. Lehmkuhle then became combatant with security. Officer Andrade, Ofc. Osborne, and Officer Vanderhoof arrived on scene and observed security staff attempting to restrain Lehmkuhle on the ground just outside the entrance. While attempting to place the Lehmkuhle in handcuffs he continuously refused to place his hands behind his back. Ofc. Vanderhoof provided a spark test warning and Lehmkuhle continued to resist. Ofc. Vanderhoof then administered a drive stun on the upper middle part of Lehmkuhle's back for a full 5 second cycle. This allowed the officers secure one of Lehmkuhle's hands. The officers continued to tell Lehmkuhle to place his other hand behind his back and he continued to refuse by grabbing the railing next to him. Ofc. Vanderhoof provided another spark test warning, and the Lehmkuhle hesitantly placed his other hand behind his back allowing the officers to full secure his hands.

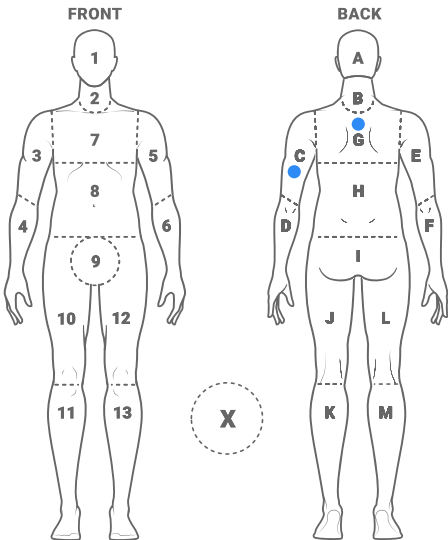

Narrative

NARRATIVE OF INCIDENT

On Friday 09/26/2025 at approximately 2047, I (Ofc. Vanderhoof) was dispatched to 224 Duval St (Bull and Whistle) in reference to a physical altercation taking place between a trespassing male and the bar staff.

Ofc. Andrade was already on scene attempting to restrain the male, later identified as Lonnie Lehmkuhle (Arrestee).

I arrived and attempted to help Ofc. Andrade place the male in handcuffs. Ofc. Andrade and I informed Lehmkuhle to place his hands behind his back multiple times. Lehmkuhle continued to resist and refuse our lawful orders. I informed Lehmkuhle that he would be tased if he did not place his hands behind his back and provided a spark test warning. Lehmkuhle continued to resist so I drive stunned him in the upper middle part of his back for a full 5 second cycle. Ofc. Andrade, Ofc. Osborne and I were able to handcuff one of the males' hands. We continued to tell the male to place his other hand behind his back and he continued to refuse by grabbing the railing next to him. I provided another spark test warning, and the male hesitantly placed his other hand behind his back. We were able to handcuff both hands behind his back and begin moving him to my patrol vehicle where he was searched and placed in the back of my patrol vehicle.

After Lehmkuhle was secured in my patrol vehicle I was able to talk to a bouncer, identified as Kevin Santana, at the Bull and Whistle who stated the following in summary;

he noticed Lehmkuhle was stumbling around on the third floor of the property and was asked to leave. Lehmkuhle initially complied and started walking down the stairs when he turned around and stated he left a bag. The staff informed Lehmkuhle he had to leave the property. Lehmkuhle became combative and started physically fighting his way back on to the property. Lehmkuhle was detained by the bar staff until Ofc. Andrade arrived.

I also spoke to Ofc. Andrade who informed me that when he arrived, he noticed the male being held down by the bar staff. Ofc. Andrade stated he went over to assist and identified himself as an Officer with the Key West Police Department, this is when I (Ofc. Vanderhoof) arrived on scene.

Lehmkuhle was transported to the Lower Keys Medical Center where he was cleared by medical staff. Lehmkuhle was then transported to the Monroe County Detention Center where he was turned over to the detention center staff.

Based on the facts and the evidence I have probable cause to believe that on 09/26/2025 Lonnie Lehmkuhle intentionally violated F.S.S. 810.09-2B Trespassing Failure to Leave Property Upon Order by intentionally remaining on the property 224 Duval St after being told to leave by the bar staff.

Based on the facts and the evidence I have probable cause to believe that on 09/26/2025 Lonnie Lehmkuhle intentionally violated F.S.S. 509.143 Disorderly Conduct on a Licensed Establishment by fighting with the bar staff and being so combative on the property that he had to be physically restrained until police arrived.

Based on the facts and the evidence I have probable cause to believe that on 09/26/2025 Lonnie Lehmkuhle intentionally violated F.S.S. 843.02 Resisting W/O Violence by refusing to place his hands behind his back to be arrested after being told numerous times to do so by Ofc. Andrade, Ofc. Osborne and I while we were performing our legal lawful duties as uniformed Law Enforcement Officers.

My BWC was active for the encounter. I uploaded my BWC footage to Evidence.com.

At this time, no further information.
