## **Training & Accomplishments**

- The **Key West Fire Department Dive Team** conducted dive training exercises at the College of the Florida Keys lagoon.
- Our Pediatric Champion attended the State Pediatric Symposium, receiving advanced training to enhance pediatric emergency care and share new practices with the department.
- The **EMS Division** hosted a **Leadership and Ethics Training** course in partnership with Braxton College. This course was attended by all on-duty crews and administrative staff.
- Class 43 Ambassadors visited Station 1 for an orientation, learning about the operations and responsibilities of each division within the department.
- One department member successfully completed the **Provisional Paramedic Program**, passing the final assessment under the supervision of the Medical Director.
