SUBJECT: City of Key West and Monroe County Sheriff's Office Tropical Storm/ Hurricane Parking Inter-local Agreement

ACTION STATEMENT: This resolution authorizes a Tropical Storm/ Hurricane Parking Inter-local Agreement between City of Key West and Monroe County Sheriff's Office.

BACKGROUND:

The property at the City of Key West owned landfill, 5701 College Road, Stock Island, Florida is substantially higher in elevation than surrounding areas, including the area used by the Monroe County Sheriff's Office to park patrol, emergency, law enforcement, and personnel support vehicles. During Tropical Storms/ Hurricane events the possibility of flooding exists.

PURPOSE AND JUSTIFICATION: In an effort to protect the investment of public funds and promote public safety after Tropical Storm/ Hurricane events, the Monroe County Sheriff's Office has requested parking area, at no cost, for thirty (30) Monroe County Sheriff's Office owned vehicles at the City of Key West owned landfill, 5701 College Road, Stock Island, Florida. These vehicles consist of patrol, emergency, law enforcement, and personnel support. The term of this Inter-local Agreement shall be a period of three (3) years.

OPTIONS:

- 1. Approve the Tropical Storm/ Hurricane Parking Inter-local Agreement between City of Key West and Monroe County Sheriff's Office.
- Disapprove the Tropical Storm/ Hurricane Parking Inter-local Agreement between City of Key West and Monroe County Sheriff's Office.

Key to the Caribbean – Average yearly temperature 77° F.
