On April 3, 2025 at approximately 1007 I, Detective Andrew Hudson, assisted Detective C. Curry of the Monroe County Sheriff's Office (MCSO) in locating a subject with outstanding warrants for his arrest. Detective Curry contacted me and stated he observed a silver Mitsubishi hatch back, bearing Florida registration 14EWNG, traveling East on the 300 block of Fleming St with the wanted subject, John C. Kornetti DOB 04/13/1991. As I approached the intersection of Flemming and Whitehead St, I observed the vehicle pass through the intersection and did confirm the driver to be Kornetti. Detective Curry then activated his red/blue emergency lights at which time the vehicle came to a stop at the intersection of Fleming and Bahama St.

On initial contact, Detective C. Curry instructed Kornetti to exit the vehicle and the passenger (Christelle B. Willis DOB 5/14/1983) to remain in her seat; they complied. I then placed the subject in handcuffs and did note Kornetti's movements to be erratic and wouldn't stand still even when instructed. Kornetti then told Detective C. Curry that he had narcotics in his socks. I removed both Kornetti's socks and did not locate any illicit substances. Kornetti then said if was under the driver's seat.

I leaned into the vehicle and immediately felt Kornetti's body push into mine at which time I began to turn and heard Detective C. Curry give Kornetti repetitive commands to "spit it out". While Detective Curry attempted to prevent the narcotics from being ingested and struggle ensued which resulted in Kornetti falling. I assisted Detective Curry in gaining control by holding Kornetti's right shoulder and hand. During this time I saw two small bags containing a brown substance; one of which was broken and spilled on the pavement.

Once we regained control of Kornetti, the substance (FTP Fentanyl) was collected. The collected narcotics had an approximate combined weight of 5.6 grams.

Kornetti and the vehicles interior were searched.

No other items were found on Kornetti; inside the vehicle I located several small plastic bags with a brown residue, tin foil, and \$2,020 inside of a wallet with Kornetti identification as well as an envelope that displayed Kornetti's name containing \$3,200.

Detective C. Curry took possession of all items.

Detective Sergeant J. Conaty responded to gather information and document any possible injuries.

Kornetti was transported to the Monroe County Detention Center without incident by Officer J. Torrecillas.

Willis was released along with the vehicle.

It should be noted, my bodyworn camera (BWC) was not active during this event as I dropped it while exiting my vehicle to handcuff the subject. Kornetti was also offered medical services but refused and stated he was uninjured.

Nothing further at this time.

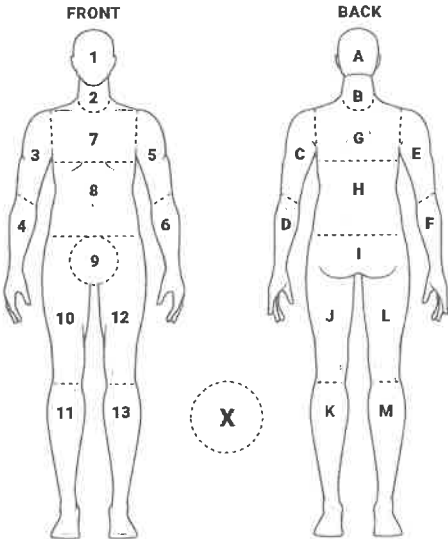

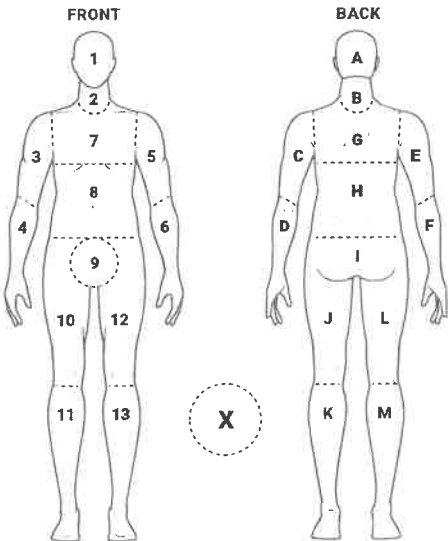

Narrative

NARRATIVE OF INCIDENT
Det. Hudson was assisting MCSO Det. Curry to look for a wanted subject with an active arrest warrant for narcotics. MCSO Det. Curry initiated a traffic stop on the subject at Fleming St./Bahama Street. Det. Hudson placed the subject into handcuffs. While Det. Hudson was looking inside the vehicle, MCSO Det. Curry maintained control of the subject. The subject then attempted to get out of MCSO Det. Curry's control to discard narcotics. MCSO Det. Curry then gave loud verbal commands for the subject to stop, who did not comply. MCSO Det. Curry initiated a takedown of the subject and Det. Hudson assisted in gaining physical control of the subject. Det. Hudson's BWC fell off of his person prior to making contact with the subject. Rescue responded to evaluate the subject, but there were no injuries. I responded to the scene and photographed the subject. A bystander had captured video of the incident and given it to MCSO Det. Curry. The bystander left prior to my arrival, and his information was not obtained. No injuries to officers involved.
