A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, APPROVING "AMENDMENT (1ST AMENDMENT) TO AGREEMENT" ID #2878 TO EXTEND THE TERMINATION DATE TO MARCH 31, 2025 FOR TOURIST DEVELOPMENT COUNCIL FUNDING OF THE PAVILIONS AT SMATHERS BEACH PROJECT; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE NECESSARY DOCUMENTS UPON CONSENT OF THE CITY ATTORNEY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, in Resolution 22-194 the City of Key West accepted a Grant Award from the Tourist Development Council to assist with a tourism impact study and with improvements including demolition and replacement of the seven (7) pavilions at Smathers Beach (Agreement ID #2878); and

WHEREAS, City staff recommends approving the attached Amendment to Agreement ID #2878, which grants a no-cost time extension for the project; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the attached "Amendment (1st Amendment) to Agreement" (ID #2878), to extend the termination date for the Pavilions at Smathers Beach project to March 31, 2025, is hereby approved.

Section 2: That no cost adjustments are associated with this time extension.

Section 3: That the City Manager is authorized to execute any necessary documents, upon consent of the City Attorney.

Section 4: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the Presiding Officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
