A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE KEY WEST, FLORIDA, CITY OF RESOLUTION 14-060 TO ADJUST THE PROCUREMENT PRICE AUTHORIZED FOR THE PURCHASE OF UP TO THREE (3) CLEAN DIESEL (LOW SULFUR) GILLIG 30' LOW FLOOR BRT BUSES AND ONE (1) HYBRID CLEAN DIESEL (LOW SULFUR) ELECTRIC GILLIG 30' LOW FLOOR BRT BUS TO A TOTAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$2,001,983.00, PURSUANT TO STATE CONTRACT, PURSUANT TO SECTIONS 2-797(1)(3) ORDINANCES: AND 2-844(A) OF THE CODE OF PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, in Resolution 14-060, the City Commission authorized the purchase of Gillig buses, pursuant to award and acceptance of an FDOT Grant and FTA Toll Revenue credits; and

WHEREAS, due to delays in the issuance of the FDOT Joint Participation Agreement for the grant funding, the procurement price quote has been adjusted to a total of \$2,001,983.00 (from \$1,990,393.00); and

WHEREAS, other terms and conditions of the purchase approved in Resolution 14-060 remain unchanged;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the procurement price for the purchase of up to three (3) clean diesel Gillig 30' Low Floor BRT Buses, and one Hybrid Clean Diesel Electric Gillig 30' Low Floor BRT Bus, previously approved in Resolution 14-060, is hereby adjusted and

approved in a total amount not to exceed \$2,001,983.00, pursuant
to sections $2-797(1)(3)$ and $2-844(A)$ of the Code of Ordinances.
Section 2: Other terms and conditions of Resolution 14-
060 shall remain unchanged.
Section 3: That this Resolution shall go into effect
immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by
the signature of the Presiding Officer and the Clerk of the
Commission.
