A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA AWARDING RFP #25-017 TO WASTE MANAGEMENT INC. OF FLORIDA TO PROVIDE SLUDGE TRANSPORTATION AND DISPOSAL SERVICES FOR THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, OR DESIGNEE, TO NEGOTIATE AND EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH WASTE MANAGEMENT INC. OF FLORIDA FOR AN INITIAL TERM OF THREE (3) YEARS, COMMENCING UPON EXECUTION, AND TO EXECUTE ANY RELATED DOCUMENTS, ADMINISTRATIVE ACTIONS, BUDGET TRANSFERS/ ADJUSTMENTS OR CONTRACT MODIFICATIONS NECESSARY FOR IMPLEMENTATION OF THE CONTRACT, UPON CONSENT OF THE CITY ATTORNEY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on July 31, 2025, the City of Key West released Request for Proposals (RFP) No. 25-017, "*Sludge Transportation and Disposal Services*" in accordance with the procurement ordinance of the City of Key West, Florida and Florida competitive solicitation requirements; and

WHEREAS, RFP #25-017 was publicly noticed in *The Key West Citizen* newspaper and posted on DemandStar, the electronic procurement portal, and providing a submission window of twenty (20) calendar days to allow for fair and open competition; and

WHEREAS, on August 20, 2025 sealed proposals were formally opened at the City Clerk's Office with only one (1) responsive proposal received from Waste Management Inc. of Florida; and

WHEREAS, the proposal submitted by Waste Management Inc. of Florida presented detailed service rates for sludge transportation and disposal services consistent with the RFP's scope of services

which, upon review, it was determined the proposal satisfied all essential criteria, including technical requirements, operational capacity and regulatory obligations; and

WHEREAS, the proposal received from Waste Management Inc. of Florida included the following Unit Price Proposal Form for Transportation and Disposal; and

Waste Management Inc. of Florida - Key West Sludge Transportation and Disposal Services

WHEREAS, given the absence of competing proposals, Waste Management's submission was evaluated under the established principles of responsibility, responsiveness and price reasonableness to ensure the proposed contract represents fair market value and safeguards the City's fiscal interests. While the City retains the option to re-advertise the solicitation in an effort to encourage additional competition, such action would create a substantial risk of service interruption, thereby leaving the City without the essential sludge transportation and disposal services required to maintain public health, safety and regulatory compliance; and

WHEREAS, the proposed contract with Waste Management Inc. of Florida establishes unit prices for sludge transportation and disposal services on a per-ton basis. Because the annual volume of sludge generated by the City varies based on wastewater treatment plant operations and seasonal demand, the total annual expenditure cannot be predetermined; and

WHEREAS, the contract is structured as a unit-price agreement wherein the City is billed based on the actual tons of sludge transported and disposed of during the contract term. This payment model ensures fiscal prudence by aligning costs directly with the service levels provided; and

WHEREAS, funding for these services has been appropriated in the City's FY 2025-2026 Adopted Budget under the Wastewater Enterprise Fund (Account Number 4013504-5353400 - Other Contractual Services). Actual expenditures will be contingent upon operational volumes during the term of the agreement; and

WHEREAS, staff recommends the City Commission award RFP #25-017 to Waste Management Inc. of Florida to ensure continuity of essential sludge transportation and disposal services for the City of Key West, mitigate the legal and financial risks associated with service disruption and secure a vendor with demonstrated capability and regulatory compliance;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the City Commission hereby awards RFP #25-017 to Waste Management Inc. of Florida to provide Sludge Transportation and Disposal Services for the City of Key West, Florida.

Section 2: That the City Manager, or designee, is hereby authorized to negotiate and execute a contract with Waste Management Inc. of Florida to provide Sludge Transportation and Disposal Services for the City of Key West, Florida for an initial three (3) year term, to commence upon execution, and to execute any necessary related administrative actions, documents, budget transfers/adjustments or contract modifications necessary for

implementation of the contract within the approved budget, upon consent of the City Attorney.

Section 3: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the Presiding Officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
