- CFK may construct dormitories for up to 340 student beds
- An additional 25 units for employees, educators, and first responders

Lagoon Landing

Existing Dormitory

- Opened in 2011
- 100 student bed facility
- Comprised of four- and five-bedroom suites
- Additional studio for the on-property manager
- Waitlist of potential residents since property opened
- 243 CFK applicants requested on-campus housing, but could not be accommodated
- ▶ 40 of those applicants secured off-campus housing
- Approximately 80% of Lagoon Landing residents work in our community



GROUND FLOOR

The ground floor will include 48 covered parking spaces, a lobby with security, dining hall, and outdoor patio.






2ND, 3RD and 4TH FLOOR PLAN - STUDENT SUITES

The second, third, and fourth floors will include at least eight four-bedroom/two-bathroom suites, a lounge, and a resident assistant (RA) unit. One floor will house the laundry facility. Floors two, three, and four are expected to accommodate over 200 students.






5TH FLOOR PLAN - EMPLOYEE SUITES

The fifth floor will include 25 employee units with two-bedroom/one-bathroom, one-bedroom/one-bathroom, and studio options. Employees will have a designated outdoor terrace and lobby.

What Does CFK need from the City?

The College of the Florida Keys ("CFK"), pursuant to Section 380.0666, F.S., is requesting five million dollars (\$5,000,000.00) from the Monroe County Land Authority ("MCLA") for CFK's construction of at least twenty-five (25) affordable workforce housing units for CFK employees, or when available and not provided to employees, Monroe County's workforce (the "Project"). The Project is to be developed on CFK's property located at 5901 College Road, Key West, Florida 33040, bearing Property ID No. 00072080-000900 (the "Property").
