Introduction

The City Manager's Office request the approval of the "26th Annual Key West Lobsterfest" on the 100-500 block of Duval Street on Saturday, August 12, 2023, from noon to 11:00 p.m.

Background

The City Manager's Office has received an application from "Key West Promotions, Inc.." for the "26th Annual Key West Lobsterfest" on Saturday, August 12, 2023, from noon to 11:00 p.m. Lobsterfest is a celebration of the opening of commercial lobster season. The street fair showcases local restaurants as they sell their best lobster dishes streetside. Shopping is available from arts & crafts vendors as well as a free concert on the main stage at the intersection of Duval & Greene Streets with performances by local entertainers. Historically, there are approximately five thousand people that attend the festival. The event is open to the public. The applicant has agreed to abide by City Codes and Ordinances, including providing insurance.

Procurement

There will be no additional expenses to the city as all service costs (Police/Fire/Community Services) are covered by the applicant, based on the Special Event Matrix.
