**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE

ATTACHED FIRST AMENDMENT TO CITY MANAGER

WHEREAS, at City Commission meeting on January 7, 2025, in Resolution No. 25-003, the City Commission approved the employment agreement between the City of Key West and Brian L. Barroso; and

WHEREAS, Barroso's performance as City Manager has stabilized the administration of City government and worked to instill confidence in its operations for the position of City Manager; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager employment agreement agree to reopen the issues of salary, benefits and health insurance after completion of the first successful year provided that the City Manager has made substantial progress in obtaining certification as a Florida Certified Public Manager by the Florida City and County Management Association, or has achieved "candidate status" with the International City/County Management Association, or equivalent organization.
