## Safety & Vision Zero



- Headlights and taillights are available at City Hall and the Monroe County Public Library
  - 1040 lights provided

  - Staples & 4th St
- In-Street Pedestrian Signs along Bertha St
- Safety Action Plan Task Force
  - Second meeting, July 14th, included broad community representation.
  - Crash Data Analysis - 63% increase in 2024

- **S Roosevelt Blvd** Completed
- **South St** Completed
- **North Roosevelt Blvd at Palm Ave** ([434684-4-52-01](#)) Complete
- **Truman Ave and White St Signalization** ([434684-5-52-01](#)) Complete
- **Staples Ave Pedestrian Bridge** Permanent counter installed / not yet reporting to dashboard
- **Staples Ave & 4th St** Construction in Sept.
- **Southernmost Point Plaza** Out for construction bid
- **North Roosevelt Blvd RRR** ([446011-1](#))([446011-2](#)) Safety Audit completed and a reduction of three crashes per year can be achieved by recommendations: access management, driveway width, LPI, etc.
- **US1 and East College Rd Signalization** ([449756-1-52-01](#)) Construction est. 2026. Allows for easier bus turning movements and includes roadway bicycle detection. Letting in Sept.
- **Von Phister Safety Improvements** ([456901-1-54-01](#)) FY26 construction
- **Flagler Ave Resiliency** Monroe County, 30% design
- **Caroline St (TIF)** Bicycle infrastructure awaiting construction phase.
- **Wickers** 60% design. Limited funding allocation.



# August Sustainable Transportation Update

- Safe Streets and Roads for All (SS4A) grants
  - The Key West Safety Action Plan will be completed by early 2026
    - Over 40 bike helmets were fitted during the Cops & Kids event. Plan to do helmet fittings during National Night Out on August 5<sup>th</sup>.
    - Over 700 people completed the survey.
    - Promoting the safety issue map.

    - Reviewing the equity framework to have community-based organizations instead of TCT lead on implementing the equity framework.
  - FDOT supports installing AI-powered near-miss sensors on FDOT property like US1 as long as there is no direct connection to FDOT network.
  - Contacted UF faculty about direct data connection for an AI-powered traffic crash dashboard.
- Florida laws went into effect on July 1<sup>st</sup>
  - E-bike amendment to CS/HB 567 adds the word “within” AND the e-bike age restriction. The word “within” allows Key West to do enforcement on sidewalks owned by FDOT.
  - SB 462 permits local jurisdictions to require anyone who rides a bike to carry a photo ID and set an age registration in order to ride a bike. Village of Key Biscayne will be voting on this topic on August 19<sup>th</sup>.
- Electric buses
  - Researching RFP and RFQ examples to use for creating the Electric Bus and Fleet Plan
  - FDOT rejected request to include wireless EV charging in Long Key Bridge and Seven Mile Bridge PD&E studies. Florida Keys Scenic Corridor Alliance sent a letter to FDOT to request wireless EV charging. FDOT hasn't replied to this request.
  - Nasim is volunteering for the Florida Keys Scenic Corridor Alliance to do transit planning for Key West.
- Bikeshare program
  - Plan to collaborate with Multimodal to start discussing with local bike rental companies to launch bikeshare program
- Bike racks
  - Collaborate with Multimodal to review bike rack installs
