If with this locations expansion the intent was to request this permit, we would never had agreed to the setbacks. The proximity to my church St. Mary's (which we are a member of its congregation), St. Mary's School and the families with children that live in this area including our property, I do not agree to increase the number of locations to sell alcohol to the public. There is sufficient establishments set up already in the close proximity, that we do not feel a need for another establishment to sell alcohol. To whom it may concern,


