A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, RATIFYING THE PROCUREMENT OF A BA150E TRAILER PUMP PACKAGE, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$79,939.00, FROM BBA PUMPS, INC., PURSUANT TO SECTION 2-797(2) OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, EMERGENCY PROCUREMENT, AND IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 2-797(3) OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, PURCHASE UNDER CONTRACTS OF THE GOVERNMENTAL PURCHASING COOPERATIVE PROGRAMS; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ANY NECESSARY DOCUMENTS AND BUDGET TRANSFERS, UPON THE CONSENT OF THE CITY ATTORNEY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Key West owns, operates, and maintains the stormwater management system and sanitary sewer collection transmission system, and a trailer-mounted, high-capacity pump is necessary to alleviate stormwater flooding on city streets and pump out sewage lift station for repairs and equipment replacement; and

WHEREAS, the city manager approved the emergency procurement of one BA150E trailer pump package from BBA Pumps, Inc., in the amount of \$79,939.00, in accordance with the Sheriff's Association cooperative purchasing contract; and

WHEREAS, Section 2-797(2) of the Code of Ordinances allows the City Manager to make emergency procurement of commodities where the cost exceeds \$50,000.00 when there exists a clear and present threat to public health, property, welfare, safety or other substantial loss to the city; and

WHEREAS, Section 2-797(3) of the Code of Ordinances authorizes procurement under governmental purchasing cooperative programs provided that the city commission authorizes procurement when the cost exceeds \$50,000.00; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the emergency procurement of one BA150E Trailer Pump Package from BBA Pumps, Inc., in the amount OF \$79,939.00, pursuant to City of Key West Code of Ordinances Section 2-797(2) emergency procurement and Section (3) purchases under contracts of the Governmental Purchasing Cooperative Program, is hereby approved.

Section 2. That funds for procurement of BA150E Trailer Pump Package will be split between sewer renewal and replacement fund 4013503-5356400 and stormwater repairs and maintenance fund 4023804-5386400. Budget transfer within the sewer fund and budget transfer within the stormwater fund are hereby authorized.

Section 3. That the City Commission hereby authorizes the City Manager to execute any necessary documents and budget transfers, upon consent of the City Attorney.

Section 4. That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the Presiding Officer and the Clerk of the

Commission.
