A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO INVESTIGATE THE FEASIBILITY OF CREATING AFFORDABLE HOUSING ON THE CITY OWNED PROPERTY CURRENTLY LEASED TO THE FLORIDA KEYS MOSQUITO CONTROL DISTRICT; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the Florida Keys Mosquito Control District is on a short term lease with the City and is moving their operations; and

WHEREAS, the City of Key West finds that the use of its property for affordable housing serves a great public purpose; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the City Manager is hereby directed to investigate the potential for affordable housing on the City owned property that is currently leased to the Florida Keys Mosquito Control District.

Section 2: That the City Manager is directed to report on the potential use of the property for affordable housing, and

in particular dormitory style housing, to the City Commission within 60 days.

Section 3: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the presiding officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
