On June 17, 2023, at approximately 0630 hours, Ofc Stevens and I (Ofc Betz) responded to 527 Duval, Walgreens in reference to a stolen bicycle.

On arrival, I met with Richard Ruvido, victim, who stated someone had taken his Wicker's Guesthouse rental bicycle from the front of Walgreens. Ruvido advised he briefly walked into Walgreens to make a purchase and when he walked out, his rental bike was taken.

I spoke with Isis Santana, manager, who showed me the video of the incident. The video showed Ruvido park his bike near the entrance of the Walgreens. Ruvido failed to lock the bicycle and entered the store. While Ruvido was in the store, a white male, known to me as Garfield Bishop, walked directly to the bike from the area of Applerouth Lane. Bishop then took Ruvido's rental bike from the front of the store. Bishop left the scene heading south on Duval.

Ruvido was able to provide me with the serial number for the bicycle as SNB051900180. Ruvido described the bike as a blue Sun Boardwalk bicycle and valued the bike as \$520.

Ofc Stevens and I canvassed the area for Bishop with negative contact.

At approximately 0725, KWPD Dispatch advised Santana, Walgreen's manager, advised Bishop had returned from the scene. Ofc Steves, Ofc Howell and I responded to the location. On arrival, I was directed to the rear of the store near the reading glasses. One of the employees advised she observed Bishop in that area looking at the glasses.

I approached Bishop, who was now wearing reading glasses. I took Bishop by the left wrist and placed him into handcuffs. When I took Bishop's right arm, he advised he had a "broken arm". I turned Bishop's arm in a more comfortable position and placed him into handcuff's. One of the employees handed me the packaging for the glasses, which Bishop removed before placing them on his face.

Ofc Howell arrived on scene. I walked Bishop to my patrol car, Ofc Stevens arrived on scene. I conducted a search incident to arrest. During my search, I located a Gillette razor, still in partial packaging in Bishop's right pocket. Bishop said, "That's my razor". I located a marijuana pen in Bishop's left pocket. I asked Bishop if he had a medical marijuana card. Bishop said he had one from Michigan, but could not produce one. I asked if he had a medical card in Florida. He said he did not.

Due to the packaging of the razor found in Bishop's pocket, I asked the employees if the razor was one of theirs. I was told it was. Ofc Stevens went to met with Santana to view the video. The video showed Bishop take the razor in it's box and begin to conceal it in his pants before walking out of view. The box with the security tag was found in the cosmetic aisle, near the area I located Bishop.

Walgreens valued the property taken by Bishop at \$21.99 for the razor and \$32.99 for the glasses (\$54.98). Ofc Stevens took custody of the marijuana pen for testing and packaging.

We were unable to locate the original victim, but we were able to contact the contractor for Wicker's Guesthouse bicycle rentals. The bike was turned over to the owner, who provided us a value of \$520.

Bishop did not initially complain of pain in his arm and just wanted me to take him to jail "so (he) can sleep". As

we stayed on scene to complete the investigation, Bishop became impatient and said his arm was hurt. Bishop told me he had already gone to the hospital and had removed a splint they had put on his arm. Bishop would then switch from having a "normal" conversation to yelling about pain. Bishop then said he was going to "press charges" against me for his arm. Bishop continued going back and forth from conversation and insults to fake groaning. At one point, Bishop would only groan and grunt when I attempted to talk.

I notified Sgt Sims over the radio of Bishop's claim and advised I would take him to LKMC for evaluation. Once at the hospital, I confirmed Bishop had been there on 6/8 for his arm. Ofc Howell and I were with Bishop when he said he was only

their to try to get pain pills. Bishop was medically cleared. I transported Bishop to MCDC for processing.

Ofc Stevens advised he field tested the vape pen. He advised it field tested positive. Ofc Stevens advised the wiegh of the liquid and device was 30 grams.

Since Bishop did take Ruvido's rental bike, valued at \$520, without permission, Bishop was in violation of FSS 812.014-2e.

Since Bishop did take merchandise from Walgreen valued at \$54.98 and attempted to conceal the merchadise without purchasing, Bishop was in violation of FSS 812.014-3a.

Since Bishop was in possession of a marijuana vape pen which weighed 30 grams, Bishop was in violation of FSS 893.13-6a.

There is no BWC from me for this encounter due to battery failure.

There is in-car video and video from other officers.

Victim's Rights Brochures were issued.
