A RESOLUTION OF THE CAROLINE STREET CORRIDOR AND BAHAMA VILLAGE COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY (CRA) APPROVING A MONTH-TO-MONTH EXTENSION OF THE CONTRACT AUTHORIZED IN RESOLUTION NO. 08-043, AND EXTENDED FOR TWO YEARS IN RESOLUTION NO. 11-091, BETWEEN THE CITY OF KEY WEST AND CRA, AND MONROE ASSOCIATION FOR RETARDED CITIZENS, INC. ("MARC") FOR TRASH COLLECTION SERVICES AT KEY WEST BIGHT (AND GARRISON BIGHT MARINA SIMULTANEOUSLY APPROVED IN CITY COMMISSION RESOLUTION NO. 13-___); PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, in Resolutions No. 08-051 (Garrison Bight) and 08-043 (CRA for Key West Bight) the CRA/City Commission approved a three year contract, and in simultaneous Resolutions No. 11-077 (Garrison Bight) and 11-091 (CRA for Key West Bight), approved a two-year extension of the contract; and

WHEREAS, City staff has issued ITB 13-018-S, for trash collection services at Key West Bight and Garrison Bight, to replace the expired contract, and is preparing a recommendation for award of bid for approval by City Commission within the next two months; and

WHEREAS, to ensure ongoing services prior to the anticipated bid award, staff recommends a month-to-month extension of the MARC contract, until the bid is awarded, and a new contract for services is approved;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CAROLINE STREET CORRIDOR AND BAHAMA VILLAGE COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the contract between the City/CRA and MARC for trash removal at the Key West Bight and Garrison Bight is hereby extended on a month-to-month basis.

Section 2: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the presiding officer and the Clerk of the Agency.
