A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE ATTACHED "AMENDMENT NO. 3 TO THE INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN MONROE COUNTY AND THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FOR JOINT PARTICIPATION IN GRANT AGREEMENT NO. ARSO10"; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE NECESSARY DOCUMENTS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City of Key West, in partnership with the Board of Commissioners of Monroe County, City of Marathon and Islamorada, City of Islands obtained an Energy Efficiency & Conservation Block Grant (EECBG) grant under the Florida Energy and Climate Commission Grant Agreement No. ARS010, pursuant to the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act in order to implement a comprehensive energy savings project which included several cross-jurisdictional and individual community energy savings activities; and

WHEREAS, in Resolution No. 10-303, the City of Key West authorized an Interlocal Agreement with Monroe County for joint participation in the Grant Agreement No. ARS-010, and in Resolution No. 11-267 approved Amendment #1 and in Resolution No. 12-119 approved Amendment #2 to that Agreement; and

WHEREAS, at the request of Monroe County, the City Commission finds that a third amendment to the Interlocal Agreement is necessary to conform with reporting specifications for the EECBG grant;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF
THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:
Section 1: That the attached "Amendment No. 3 to the
Interlocal Agreement Between Monroe County and the City of Key
West, for Joint Participation in Grant Agreement No. ARS010" is
