-- Dominick Kelly Sanchez Arrest Narrative:

On Saturday, May 6, 2023, at approximately 4:10 AM, I, Ofc. Caldwell responded to a backup request at Tattoos and Scars located at 512 Greene Street.

Officers on scene were flagged down in reference to a physical disturbance. Ofc. Ramos and Ofc. James Young were on scene speaking with an irate suspect. I asked Ofc. James Young, if there was anyone I needed to speak with. Ofc. Young pointed me in the direction of a female wearing all black. I spoke to the female, and she stated that she observed the male that Ofc. Ramos and Ofc. Young were speaking with, punch another male rendering him unconscious. The female did not wish to provide her information to be listed as a witness nor did she wish to provide the video of the incident. This interview was recorded on my body worn camera. Sgt. Malsheimer arrived on scene and scanned the area for the injured male but was unsuccessful in locating him.

The suspect was belligerent during our encounter and continued yelling obscenities and taking steps aggressively towards officers. Because of this, the suspect was detained and placed into handcuffs. Because the other party could not be located and the witness did not wish to cooperate with the investigation, Ofc. Ramos agreed to allow the suspect to walk away. We offered to drive the suspect to another location. The male remained on scene and continued to cause a disturbance.

As the suspect began to walk away, based on my experience, I observed what appeared to be a green, marijuana vape pen with a brown liquid inside of a cartridge fall from the male's belongings. I can be heard on my body camera stating that he dropped it. I attempted to stop the male from walking away again to investigate the marijuana vape pen. The male began to actively resist and pulled his hand away from me two times when I attempted to control the male's arm. I utilized a rear take down to detain the male. My body camera was deactivated in the process of the takedown. Ofc. Ramos and Ofc. Young assisted in handcuffing the male.

Once the male was successfully detained, I asked him about the marijuana vape pen and he stated he bought it in Stock Island. The vape pen was a TIKI X YOCAN. It contained a brown liquid inside of an attached cartridge that read "CCELL". The brown liquid inside of the cell field tested positive for THC. No Medical Marijuana card was produced. The vape pen was not in an original dispensary container delcaring what it was nor where it came from.

Ofc. Ramos transported the male to Monroe County Detention Center. I stayed on scene to interview any witnesses of the takedown, but all parties had cleared the area. Once at Monroe County Detention Center the suspect continued being combative with the jail staff.

Ofc. Ramos provided me with a photograph of the arrestee's Tennessee Driver's License. The male was identified as Dominick Kelly Sanchez, DOB 04/17/1997.

Dominick Sanchez resisted my attempts to stop him while I was engaged in the execution of a legal duty contrary to F.S.S 843.02- Resisting an officer without violence. Dominick Sanchez knew I was an officer of the law as he can be heard stating "I wish you didn't have a badge on, I'd beat the fuck out of you". This encounter was recorded on my body worn camera prior to being deactivated from the takedown.

Dominick Sanchez was in actual possession of a controlled substance (less than 20 grams) of what field tested positive for THC, contrary to F.S.S 893.13-6B. He was also in possession of the vape pen used to deliver the THC liquid contrary to F.S.S. 893.147-1.

On 5/6/2023, I (Officer James Young) responded to a suspicious incident at Tattoos and Scars (512 Greene St).

Upon arrival Officer Ramos had a male detained. Officer Ramos was investigating about an alleged battery that happen at outside of the Red Garter. The male identified himself as Dominic, due to Dominic aggressive behavior towards Officer Ramos. Officer Ramos and I escorted Dominic to Officer Ramos patrol vehicle.

Officer Caldwell asked Dominic to stop, and he refused and tried to get away. Officer Caldwell had to use a takedown move to get Dominic to the ground. Dominic was resisting with Officer Caldwell, I grabbed Dominic arm to keep still. I assisted in handcuffing Dominic when he was on the ground.

On 5/6/2023 at approximately 04:33 hours I (Officer Josue Ramos) assisted Officer Michael Caldwell after he gave Dominick Kelly Sanchez lawful orders to stop and answer for what Officer M. Caldwell believed was a pen used for smoking Marijuana. Sanchez refused to stop and pulled away from Officer M. Caldwell, and at that point Sanchez was taken to the ground to gain compliance. I assisted in gaining control of Sanchez's lower extremities and applying hand restraints. After applying hand restraints all force ceased. I along with Officer James Young assisted Sanchez to his feet. Officer J. Young and I escorted Sanchez to Officer M. Caldwell's marked Key West Police Department patrol vehicle. While escorting Sanchez he continued to brace and tense up, so I applied a bent wrist escort technique to gain compliance. Officer J. Young and I placed Sanchez in the back of Officer M. Caldwell's KWPD patrol vehicle.

I had a KWPD Ride-Along (Corey James Vanderhoof) with me observing my patrol duties for the night, and he witnessed the event. Vanderhoof completed a KWPD Statement form and that was later submitted to records.

Due to the use of Force Officer M. Caldwell asked me to transport Sanchez in my KWPD patrol vehicle. Officer Veronica Roman, and K-9 Officer Mathew Hansel assisted in escorting Sanchez to my patrol vehicle.

I transported Sanchez to the Monroe County Detention Facility without incident.

My Axon BWC was activated for the incident and later uploaded to Evidence.com.

My Coban In-car was activated for the incident and was later uploaded.

I had no further involvement with this incident.
