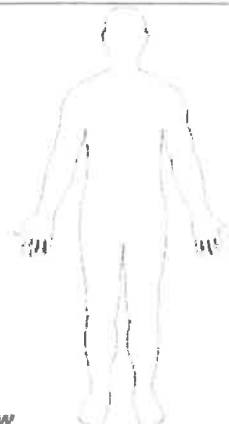
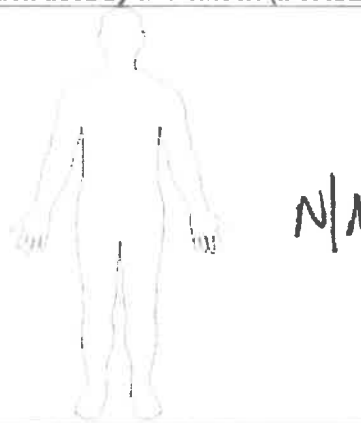
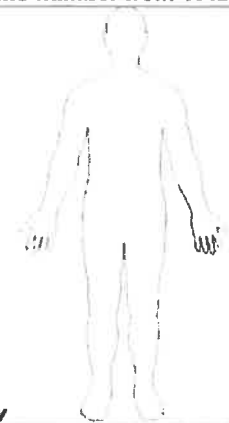

the above named defendant committed the above offenses charged and the facts showing probable cause to believe the same are as follows

On Friday, December 28, 2018, at approximately 1006 hours, Chief Brandenburg aired over Key West Channel #1 he was in the Monroe County Sheriff's Office jurisdiction and was attempting to stop a vehicle. Chief Brandenburg told Key West Communications Channel #1 a brown, SUV was observed traveling at a high rate of speed, failing to maintain its lane and overall driving recklessly. Chief Brandenburg stated his emergency lights were activated, along with his siren. I was able to hear the siren in Chief Brandenburg's radio transmissions. At one

point, Chief Brandenburg observed the SUV driving in the grass median, still at a high rate of speed. The SUV failed to slow and stop for Chief Brandenburg. Chief Brandenburg was able to obtain the SUV's license plate as a Florida tag bearing license plate number CAMN83 and he described the SUV as a brown Ford Expedition. Chief Brandenburg turned off his lights and siren after he realized the SUV was not going to stop for him.

Officer Bouvier and Officer Morris were sitting at the exit / entrance lane of the Hyatt on Overseas Highway and observed the brown, 2006, Ford, Expedition, bearing Florida tag #CAMN83, traveling westbound on Overseas Highway and strike a pickup truck from the rear. The Expedition swerved to the left to overtake the pickup truck and continued westbound on Overseas Highway. The Expedition swerved back to the right and Officer Bouvier attempted to back up (driver of the marked patrol vehicle) to avoid a collision. The front of the Expedition struck the left front of Officer Bouvier's patrol vehicle, removing the front bumper and causing engine damage to the patrol car, eventually disabling it. Continuing westbound on US1, the Expedition then struck a Mercedes-Benz causing damage to the passenger door and front right quarter panel and a Dodge pickup truck in the right rear quarter panel.

The Expedition continued westbound on Overseas Highway, struck the raised, safety barrier on N. Roosevelt Blvd., striking two traffic control signs and then two vehicles, stopped within the two left turn lanes on N. Roosevelt Blvd. The expedition was disabled after the collision with the two vehicles in the turn lane.

Officer O'Connell was at the intersection of N. Roosevelt Blvd. and Overseas Highway at the time of the crash. Officer O'Connell rushed to the Expedition and detained the driver, identified as Jessica Ruth Vanhorn through F/NCIC.

Key West Fire / Rescue responded to the scene to assist with providing care to the injured persons on scene. Key West Fire / Rescue transported the passenger of the last vehicle struck (Black Kia), who complained of a headache and knee pain.

I spoke with Vanhorn, who was still in Officer O'Connell's patrol car. I observed Vanhorn was visibly shaking, shivering as if she was cold, disheveled hair and clothing, with her hair in her face. I noticed Vanhorn's shirt was inside out. Vanhorn showed extreme mood swings, ranging from apologetic to angry. Vanhorn made a spontaneous statement, "I'm sober. I'm not under the influence of nothing". Vanhorn's speech pattern was shaky and she elongated her words while speaking. Vanhorn's eyelids were droopy and her eyes were glassy, red and bloodshot. I did not smell the presence of alcohol on Vanhorn's person.

Vanhorn complained of injury and was transported to Lower Keys Medical Center by ambulance. With Vanhorn showing signs of impairment, likely due to drug usage, Officer Purcell rode with Vanhorn to the hospital. Officer O'Connell followed behind the ambulance and remained with Vanhorn as she received medical treatment. Vanhorn received a CAT Scan, amongst a battery of medical tests. Nothing showed of injury

during the medical tests.

Vanhorn was agitated with the Emergency Room Staff, uncooperative and she continuously yelled for pain medication. Vanhorn was given Fentanyl for her pain. Vanhorn was still complaining of pain, however she was not given more medication.

Vanhorn was released from the Emergency Room with a medical clearance.

I transported Vanhorn to the Monroe County Detention Center without incident. During the transport, I contacted Officer Andruzzi via call phone and I was told he had completed the traffic crash investigation and the supplemental investigation was turned over to me.

At the Monroe County Detention Center, Officer Purcell accompanied me to observe the DUI / DRE process.

I explained to Vanhorn the current charges she was currently in custody for. I explained to Vanhorn, Officer Andruzzi had completed his traffic crash investigation and I was now conducting a criminal DUI investigation. Vanhorn said she understood.

I asked Vanhorn if she would submit a sample of her breath to determine her breath alcohol content. Vanhorn said she had not been drinking and agreed to submit to the breath test.

I began my first 20 minute observation period and prior to completing the observation period Vanhorn said she needed to use the bathroom. I stopped the observation period and had a female deputy bring Vanhorn to the bathroom.

I explained to Vanhorn that I did not suspect alcohol to be the intoxicant in her system and that I would also be asking for urine after the breath test. Vanhorn initially refused to submit the sample and before I was able to retrieve my Implied Consent Warning Card from my pocket Vanhorn changed her mind and agreed to submit urine.

Vanhorn expressed her concern of finding an opioid within her urine since she received Fentanyl at the hospital.

The urine sample was collected by Deputy Lewis-Cox and handed to me.

I restarted the 20 minute observation period. When my 20 minute observation period had elapsed, I brought Vanhorn into the DUI Room, where the Intoxilyzer 8000 is secured. I collected two breath samples of Vanhorn's breath using the Intoxilyzer 8000 (S/N 80-0006471). The samples I collected indicated Vanhorn had a BrAC of 0.000g/210L and 0.000g/210L.

I explained to Vanhorn I was conducting a supplemental investigation to the cause of her impairment and Vanhorn agreed to submit to a DRE Evaluation.

Upon the completion of the DRE Evaluation, I determined Vanhorn was under the influence of a CNS Depressant, CNS Stimulant and THC. See the DRE Evaluation Packet for additional information.

Officer Andruzzi estimated Vanhorn caused approximately \$75,000 dollars in damage from the crash.

I ran Vanhorn's information through F/NCIC with the information I was provided. I discovered Vanhorn has two non-extraditable warrants and

her Michigan Driver's License was suspended. I ran a criminal history on Vanhorn and found she has three prior convictions for Driving while License Suspended with Knowledge. Vanhorn's conviction dates are July 23, 2016, November 07, 2016 and November 08, 2016.

I issued Vanhorn citation #AAMYZ3E for Fleeing and Attempt to Elude, citation #A0LKINE for Reckless Driving, citation #Hit and Run Crash (x4), DUI citation #A0LKIME, DUI Citation #A0LKILE for DUI Crash with Property Damage (x7) and citation #DUI and citation #AAMYZ5E for Driving while License Suspended with Knowledge (3 prior DWLS/R convictions). Vanhorn signed and accepted her citations.

Vanhorn was turned over to the Monroe County Detention Deputies for processing.

All vehicles were disabled from the damage sustained during the crash and towed from the scene by Arnold's Towing.

On Friday, December 28, 2018, at 10:06 am, Officer Bouvier and I (Officer Morris) responded to the area of the triangle, in reference to a reckless driver that Chief Brandenburg called out.

Upon arrival to the area, Officer Bouvier and I were exiting the southeast exit to The Hyatt Residence Club, 5051 Overseas Hwy, when I saw the suspect vehicle rear-end a truck that was traveling south on US 1. The suspect vehicle then drove into the right lane of US 1 and struck the front of Officer Bouvier's patrol car. The suspect vehicle then continued south on US 1 striking multiple vehicles where it came to rest.

Officer Bouvier drove south on US 1 and parked behind the suspect vehicle. I got out of the patrol car and approached the passenger side of the suspect vehicle. The suspect was taken into custody and I searched the vehicle for other passengers. There were no other passengers in the vehicle.

I directed traffic for the oncoming traffic on US 1 and I collected two written witness statements.

I activated my AXON Body Worn Camera during the incident.
