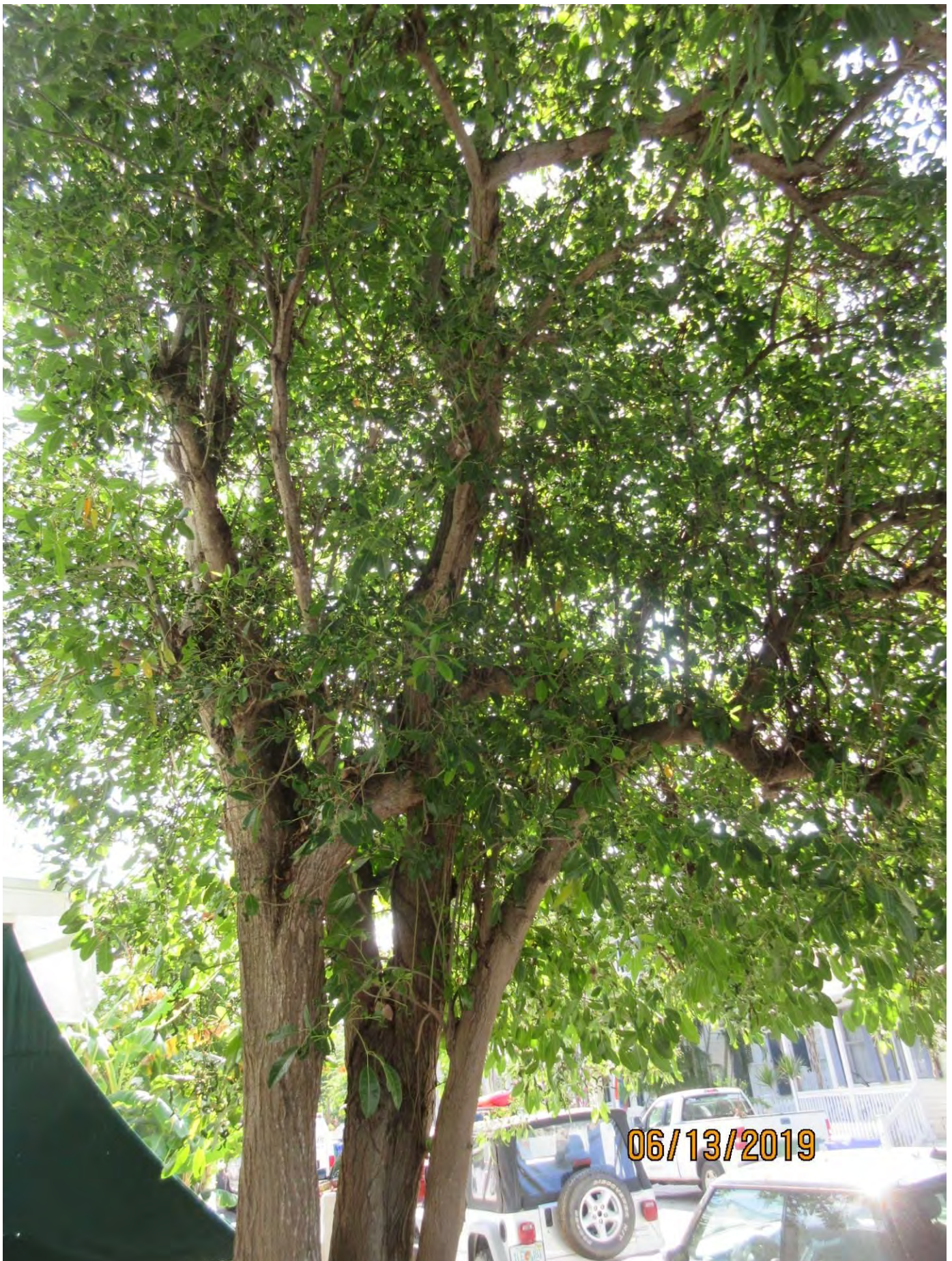

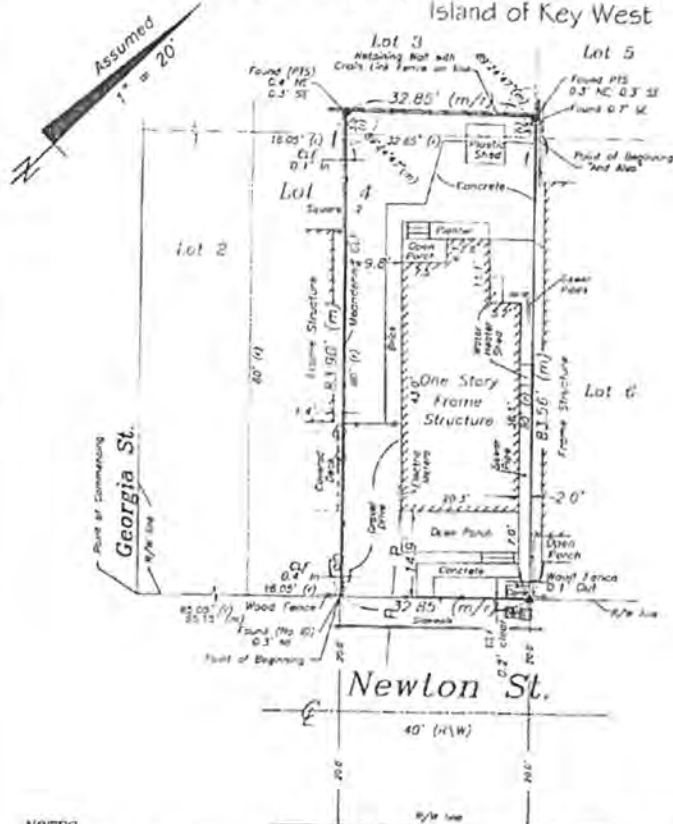

Dear Tree Commission Board:

We, Tina & Michael Mazzorana, are the new property owner of 1307 Newton Street. We are seeking approval for "A Caring Tree Company" to proceed with the below request. Our neighbors, 1305 and 1309 Newton Street, are very supportive of this proposal.

Request: An application for the approval of the following:

- Remove (6) Tabebuia Trees — 3=1307 3=1305
- Remove (2) Fichus Trees
- Trim (1) Avocado Tree
- Replacement(s) as suggested by the Commission

Rationale: Current tree locations and overgrowth has severely impacted walkways, the driveway, and risk of future windstorm impact. Specifically described as follows:

- Tree roots causing city sidewalks to lift up.
- Tabebuia trees have significant branch damage and stability issues – due to Hurricane Irma, lack of care, and significant overgrowth.
- Tabebuia trees are overgrown impacting fence lines, roots growing higher than driveway level and trunk overgrowth severely impacting our legal driveway normal use.
- Tree roots impacting our house foundation in multiple areas (Front, porch, current foundation piers and future repair piers on left side of house).
- Walkway to front home/porch entrance is cracked and lifted 12-18 inches high due to tree root growth causing hazard. Unable to create new flat walking surface due to roots.
- Tree roots extending around FCAA waterlines.
- Tree roots extending around/into sewer piping.
- Potential ADA Compliance, on public sidewalk and porch entrance due to root lift.
- Trees branches are extending into electric wiring and roofs from multiple trees.
- Tree roots possibly impacting the foundation at 1305 Newton.
- Our 1305 Newton neighbor witnessed the large Fichus tree had shifted during Hurricane Irma causing significant roof damage to their roof.

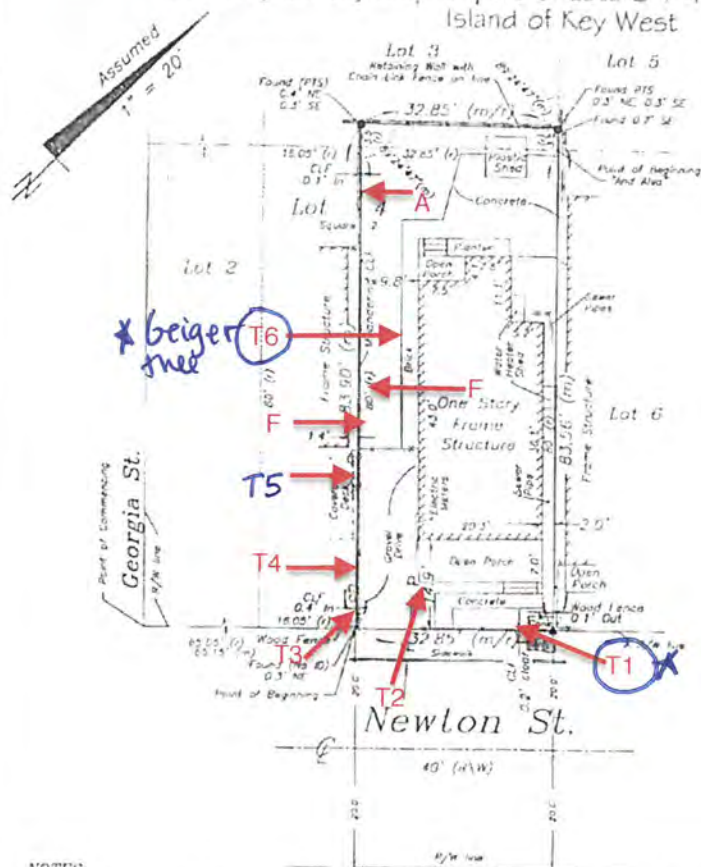

Peter, Michael, and Tina:

I have reviewed all the paperwork and measured all the trees. Below is what I have come up with:

1305 Newton: Application to remove 3-Pink Tabebuia trees (T2019-0256). Tree T3=24.2" diameter, T4=17.8" diameter, and T5=11.1" diameter. Pink Tabebuia trees are regulated if over 24" diameter therefore, at this time, no permit is required to remove these three trees.

1307 Newton: Application to remove 2-Ficus benjamina trees (T2019-0257). Ficus benjamina is listed on the not protected tree list therefore, no permit is required to remove these two trees.

1307 Newton: Application to trim 1-Avocado tree (T2019-0258). This is a staff approval process. I will need to meet with the arborist on site to discuss what is to be done prior to issuing this permit. Who are you hiring to do this work?

1307 Newton: Application to remove 2-Pink Tabebuia and 1-Geiger tree (T2019-0259). Tree T1=33.4" diameter and T2=13.3" diameter. Therefore, no permit is required to remove tree T2. The removal of T1 and the Geiger tree, a protected tree species, will require approval from the Tree Commission and will be placed on the July 9 Tree Commission agenda. The Geiger tree could be a nice tree if taken care of.

I hope this clarifies things for you all. Please keep a copy of this e-mail in your records.

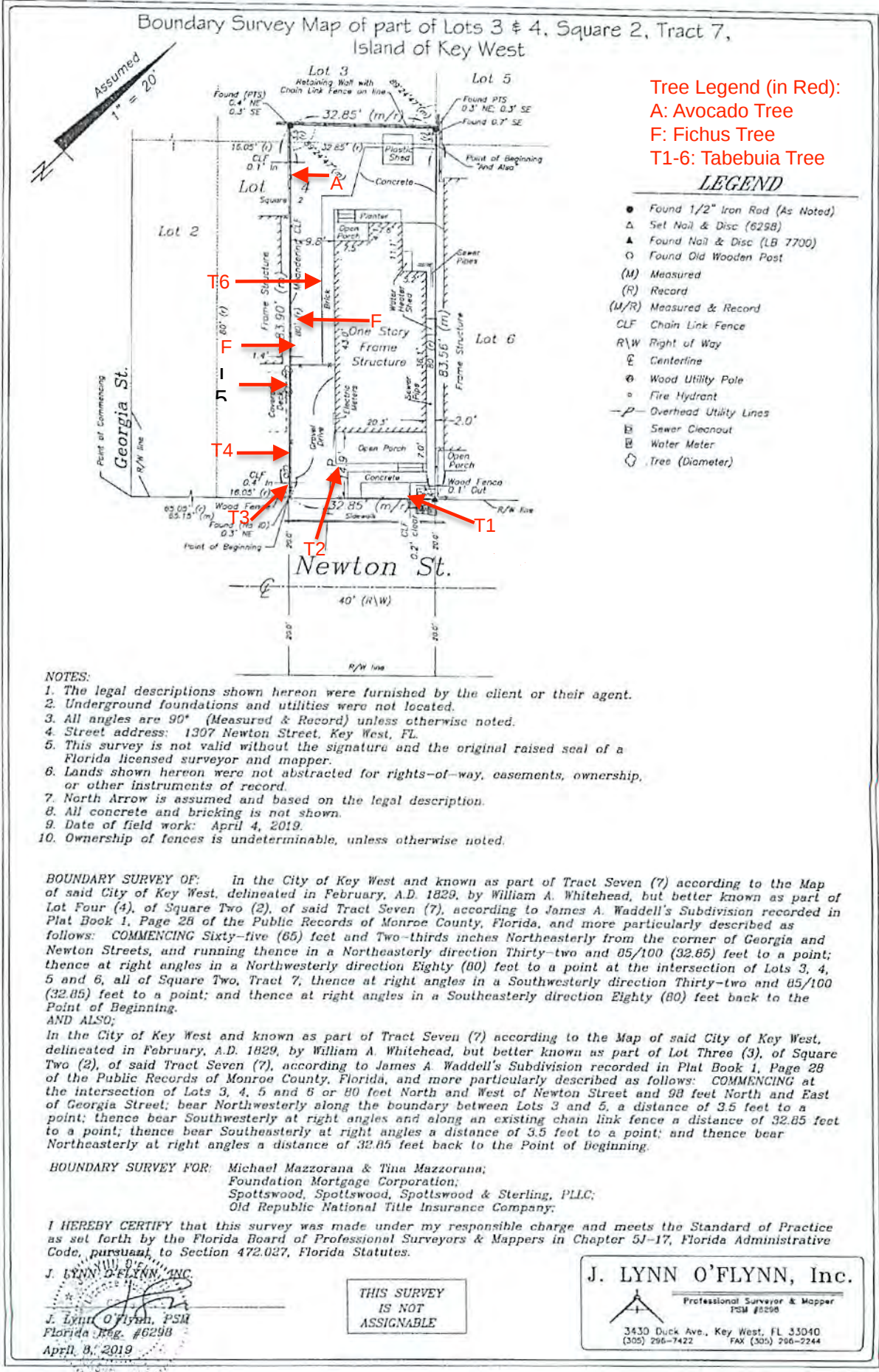
We, Tina & Michael Mazzorana, are the new property owner of 1307 Newton Street. We are seeking approval for "A Caring Tree Company" to proceed with the below request. Our neighbors, 1305 and 1309 Newton Street, are very supportive of this proposal.

Request: An application for the approval of the following:

- Remove (6) Tabebuia Trees
- Remove (2) Fichus Trees
- Trim (1) Avocado Tree
- Replacement(s) as suggested by the Commission

Rationale: Current tree locations and overgrowth has severely impacted walkways, the driveway, and risk of future windstorm impact. Specifically described as follows:

- Tree roots causing city sidewalks to lift up.
- Tabebuia trees have significant branch damage and stability issues – due to Hurricane Irma, lack of care, and significant overgrowth.
- Tabebuia trees are overgrown impacting fence lines, roots growing higher than driveway level and trunk overgrowth severely impacting our legal driveway normal use.
- Tree roots impacting our house foundation in multiple areas (Front, porch, current foundation piers and future repair piers on left side of house).
- Walkway to front home/porch entrance is cracked and lifted 12-18 inches high due to tree root growth causing hazard. Unable to create new flat walking surface due to roots.
- Tree roots extending around FCAA waterlines.
- Tree roots extending around/into sewer piping.
- Potential ADA Compliance, on public sidewalk and porch entrance due to root lift.
- Trees branches are extending into electric wiring and roofs from multiple trees.
- Tree roots possibly impacting the foundation at 1305 Newton.
- Our 1305 Newton neighbor witnessed the large Fichus tree had shifted during Hurricane Irma causing significant roof damage to their roof.

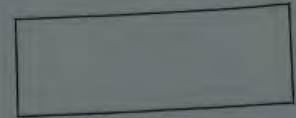

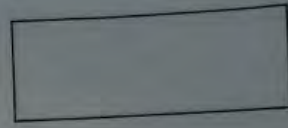
