Subject: September 2023 Key West Police Department Report


In September 2023, the Key West Police Department’s Communication Center received 6,291 calls into the dispatch center. Those calls generated 5,921 calls for service for police/fire/rescue. Compared to September 2022, we experienced a 8.8% decrease in 911 calls, a 4% decrease in non-emergency calls, and a 18% increase in calls for service for police/fire/rescue.

Officers completed 501 police reports and 153 arrests were made. Compared to September 2022, police reports decreased by 9.6% and arrests increased by 12.5%.

A total of 1,151 traffic stops (including e-bikes, stand-up scooters, bicycles, golf carts) were conducted. We issued 217 citations and 214 written warnings.






