A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AWARDING THE BID OF BURKE CONSTRUCTION GROUP, INC. FOR THE NELSON ENGLISH/WILLIE WARD RENOVATION AND ENHANCEMENT PROJECT - BV-1003, IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE TERMS SPECIFIED IN ITB 13-009, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$1,127,807.00; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT IN SUBSTANTIAL CONFORMANCE WITH THE CONTRACT DOCUMENTS CONTAINED IN THE BID PACKAGE ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, on February 6, 2013 two bids were opened in response to ITB #13-009, for the Nelson English/Willie Ward Renovation and Enhancement Project, and both bids were responsive;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the bid of Burke Construction Group, Inc. for the Nelson English/Willie Ward Park renovation and enhancement Project in accordance with the terms specified in ITB #13-009 is hereby awarded in an amount not to exceed \$1,127,807.00, including additive alternates.

Section 2: There is an allocation of Bahama Village TIF funds in the total amount of \$927,289.00 for the project. That budget amendments, including reallocation of the Infrastructure Surtax Fund in the amount of \$157,100, from the Bahama Village Band

Room Structural Analysis FY 2012-13, and an allocation of \$43,418.00 from Infrastructure Surtax Fund reserves are hereby authorized.

Section 3: That the City Manager is authorized to execute a contract in substantial conformance with the contract documents contained within the bid package on behalf of the City of Key West upon the advice and consent of the City Attorney.
