**A RESOLUTION OF THE CAROLINE STREET CORRIDOR
AND BAHAMA VILLAGE COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT
AGENCY (CRA) REJECTING ALL BIDS RECEIVED IN
RESPONSE TO INVITATION TO BID (ITB) #22-009
EXTERIOR SIGNAGE SYSTEM - KEY WEST HISTORIC
SEAPORT PURSUANT TO SECTION 2-834(3) AND (4) OF
THE CODE OF ORDINANCES; PROVIDING FOR AN
EFFECTIVE DATE**

WHEREAS, the bids received in response to ITB 22-009 were unbalanced and exceeded cost estimates for the scope of work. Accordingly, staff recommends rejecting the bids received; and

WHEREAS, at its meeting of November 9, 2022, the Key West Bight Management District Board, by Resolution, recommended that the CRA reject the bids received in response to ITB 22-009; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CAROLINE STREET CORRIDOR AND BAHAMA VILLAGE COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the all bids received in response to ITB #22-009, for Exterior Signage System - Key West Historic Seaport are hereby rejected pursuant to city code of ordinances section 2-834(3) and (4).

Section 2: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the presiding officer and the Clerk of the Agency.
