Waiving Minor Bid Informality.

ACTION STATEMENT:

This request is to approve a 3-year contract with Charley Toppino and Sons for the rehabilitation of stormwater drainage wells. The City would have an option to extend the contract for two one-year extensions at the completion of the 3-year term. This will also waive a minor bid informality.

Specific work under this contract would be performed on a task-order basis, which would require approval of the City Commission prior to award.

BACKGROUND:

The City of Key West currently owns four pump-assisted stormwater drainage well systems located at the intersection of Patricia St., & Ashby St., the North end of Simonton St. (2 wells), and the South end of White St. This City also owns 119 stormwater gravity wells with 3 more that have been designed for future construction.

Under peak flow conditions, excess silt, sand, trash, and other debris can carry through the pollution control devices of stormwater wells, thereby reducing their efficiency. Regular maintenance/cleaning work on both the pollution control devices and well structures are necessary to ensure both the pump-assist and gravity wells operate as intended.

The level of maintenance to be performed in this bid requires a certified well driller with a drill rig to perform the work. OMI regularly cleans the baffle boxes and piping, but is not a certified well driller and does not have the

vehicle (a new drill rig would cost \$600,000-\$700,000) and equipment to perform the well cleaning that would be performed under this agreement. OMI is therefore unable to provide the well-cleaning that would be proposed under this contract.

Stormwater gravity wells require well cleaning every 5-7 years, depending on various conditions (hurricanes, location, etc.). Stormwater pump-assist wells require maintenance every 2-4 years based on similar conditions. The difference in years is because the former functions on a gravity system, while the pump-assist wells are situated in areas more prone to flooding and the water is being accelerated through the pump system.

PURPOSE & JUSTIFICATION:

It is therefore in the City's best interest to enter into an agreement with a qualified stormwater well rehabilitation contractor to perform this work over a 3-year period.

According to Best Management Practices, the City is obligated to clean and maintain our stormwater wells on a regular basis, as discussed above. A consent order with the State of Florida also establishes the standards that we must maintain the wells.

The preferred well rehabilitation technique is airlift development. Under this process, large quantities of water are generated that must be disposed of properly. Chemical cleaning of the wells will be included as an add-alternative on an as-needed basis.

The City opened the bids for stormwater well maintenance on September 16, 2010. A total of five firms responded.

I propose entering into stormwater well maintenance contracts with 3 different companies. This will allow the City multiple options for having firms available to perform the work. There will be other well maintenance contracts presented to the City Commission at a future meeting. We have received a signed agreement from Charley Toppino and Sons, so we can move forward on this contract proposal now.

Work under this contract would be awarded on a task-order basis, each of which would require approval of the City Commission. Ordinarily, staff will request task-orders from the firm that can perform work capably at the lowest cost to the City. However, if that firm were to not be available, or if the City would need stormwater wells to be cleaned on an emergency basis prior to an impending storm (such as during the 2005 hurricane season), we would have the option to utilize one of our other contracted firms.

There was a minor bid informality on the Charley Toppino and Sons submittal. The well drilling license forms were not included with the original bid. Toppino's have since provided those documents.

OPTIONS:

1. Approval of this 3-year contract with Charley Toppino and Sons will help the City to maintain its stormwater gravity wells, and will give us the flexibility to have multiple firms under contract so that we can be assured work can begin promptly.

 The City could decline entering into this contract. This option is not recommended for several reasons. A consent order with the State of Florida requires us to maintain our stormwater infrastructure. And having multiple companies under contract allows the City to have increased flexibility to ensure our stormwater wells are clean prior to an arriving storm.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

There is no direct cost related to entering into a contract with this firm. However, the cost of services for any work will be established through a task order. As per the City's purchasing code, any task order exceeding \$20,000 will be brought to the City Commission for approval.

RECOMMENDATION:

The staff recommends option # 1, the approval of the 3-year contract with Charley Toppino and Sons for stormwater well maintenance and waiving the minor bid informality.

Dear Mr. Gewin:

Five (5) bids were received for the subject contract on September 16, 2010 and are summarized in the Bid Results Summary table (Exhibit 1). A summary of the required documentation that was to be included with each bid is presented in Exhibit 2. Layne Christensen and Jaffer Well Dr illing completed the Local Vendor Certification, however the local addresses they provided were more than 30 miles from Key West city limits and they do not meet the requirements to be certified as a local vendor.

We checked several references provided by each bidder and all received favorable recommendations.

We do not believe that the omission of several required forms and licenses is sufficient grounds for declaring Well Masters, Rowe Drilling Company, Jaffer Well Drilling, and Charley Toppino and Sons to be non-responsive. These items should not affect the prices or give one firm an advantage over the others. Since it is the City's intent to enter into contracts with multiple firms, we recommend that the City obtain the missing documents and certifications prior to executing a contract with any of these firms.

We recommend that the City enter into contracts with Charley Toppino and Sons, Well Masters, Layne Christensen, and Jaffer Well Drilling. Although Rowe Drilling Company appears qualified to do the work, their price is approximately three times higher than the second-highest bidder.

The CONTRACTOR, in consideration of the sum to be paid him by the OWNER and of the covenants and agreements herein contained, hereby agrees at his own proper cost and expense to do all the work and furnish all the materials, tools, labor, bonds, overhead, profit, and all appliances, machinery, and appurtenances for the Rehabilitation of Stormwater Drainage Wells, Key West, Florida to the extent of the Proposal made by the CONTRACTOR, dated the 8

day of <u>December</u> 2010, all in full compliance with the Contract Documents referred to herein.

The BIDDING REQUIREMENTS, including the signed copy of the Proposal, the CONTRACT FORMS, the PERFORMANCE AND PAYMENT BONDS, the CONDITIONS OF THE CONTRACT, the SPECIFICATIONS, and the DRAWINGS, for the Rehabilitation of Stormwater Drainage Wells, dated July 2010, are hereby referred to and by reference made a part of this Contract as fully and completely as if the same were fully set forth herein and are mutually cooperative therewith.

In consideration of the performance of the work as set forth in these Contract Documents, the OWNER agrees to pay to the CONTRACTOR an amount using the prices in the bid as adjusted in accordance with the Contract Documents, or as otherwise herein provided, and to make such payments in the manner and at the times provided in the Contract Documents. OWNER does not guarantee that the total price will be utilized through individual Work Orders.

The CONTRACTOR agrees to complete the work within the time specified in the Work Orders and to accept as full payment hereunder the amounts computed as determined by the Contract Documents and based on the said Proposal.

The CONTRACTOR agrees to remedy all defects appearing in the work or developing in the materials furnished and the workmanship performed under this Contract during the warranty period after the date of final acceptance of the work by the OWNER, and further agrees to indemnify and save the OWNER harmless from any costs encountered in remedying such defects.

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It is agreed that the Contract, based upon the Proposal, shall be fully complete within the stated number of consecutive calendar days from the date the Notice to Proceed is issued for each Work Order.

In the event that the CONTRACTOR shall fail to complete the work within the time limit or the extended time limit agreed upon, as more particularly set forth in the Contract Documents, liquidated damages shall be paid at the rate of \$500 per day. Sundays and legal holidays shall be included in determining days in default.

This Contract will automatically expire and be terminated three (3) years after the date of the execution of the Contract by the OWNER, unless the OWNER and CONTRACTOR mutually agree to up to two 1-year time extensions at the unit prices set forth in the Proposal and adjusted according to the Consumer Price Index on an annual basis beginning on October 1, 2011.

If the contract is extended, it will expire and be terminated 1- year after the date of the execution of the contract extension by the Owner.



- Question: Does the City have original as-built information on all the wells so we can establish what the original well depths were?
 Answer: Please refer to the revised Sheet 1 and Sheet 2. The table has been updated to show the permitted depth of each well. The deepest well is 127 ft.
- Question: During airlift development, can discharge water be directed to a settlement box, and then re-circulated back to the well?
 Answer: Water from development can be re-circulated back to the well provided that the conditions of Section 3.05 "Debris and Fluids Disposal" in 33 21 13.14 WATER WELL REHABILITATION are met. Paragraph 3.05 B.2 allows reinjection of the water back into the well.
- 3. Question: Does bid item no. 6, well acidization, include all work associated with acidizing the wells (the cost of the acid, mixing and placing the acid, surging 20' intervals, pumping the acid solution from the well, treating and disposing of the acid solution, etc.), or is it just for the cost of the acid and mixing and placing the acid in the well?

 Answer: Bid item number 6 should include all costs associated with

Answer: Bid item number 6 should include <u>all</u> costs associated with acidization, including (but not limited to) the ones identified in the question.

- 4. **Question:** Can we assume that there is a sanitary sewer connection within close proximity to each well site, say within 100 feet? If not, is there a sanitary sewer plan available that would indicate the locations of the sanitary sewers nearest the well sites?
 - Answer: As stated in the Bid Documents and as noted at the pre-bid meeting; it is incumbent upon each Bidder to familiarize themselves with the conditions of each site. Copies of as-builts for the City's sewer system can be made available for review at City Hall, 3140 Flagler Avenue, Key West, FL. Please call Jay Gewin at 305.809.3902 to coordinate if you are interested in viewing these documents. Note that as-builts may not be available for every site and it is ultimately the Bidder's responsibility to field-verify conditions.
- Question: Bid item no. 2 states to "Restore well to original depth, airlift for a minimum of 12 hours, operate temporary disposal system and restore site". How would we know which wells required deepening, and by how much, without knowing existing depths and original depths of the wells? It would seem that we need a separate line item for restoring wells to original depth. Answer: Please refer to the revised table of well depths, which shows the permitted depths of the wells. The City regularly measures the depth of its wells and will select individual wells for rehabilitation in each Work Order based on the amount of accumulated debris in the wells. The City intends to rehabilitate each well when open interval of each well is reduced by 30 percent, however the actual amount of debris could be more or less. For example, after a storm, one or more wells could be completely filled up to land surface with debris. Alternatively, the City may select wells with less debris accumulation.
- 6. Question: Section 33 21 13.14, par. 2.01.E.1, page 4, references section 33 21 13.09. I believe that this section is missing from the bid documents.

 Answer: Please refer to the revised Section 33 21 13.14.
- 7. Question: Can the contractor choose what type of acid is to be used for acidization?

 Answer: The City will make the determination for acid.
 - Answer: The City will make the determination for each well on a case-by-case basis. In the event a well is to be acidized, input from the Contractor will be considered in selecting the acid to be used, however the ultimate decision will be made by the City. Please note that hydrochloric acid has been eliminated from the revised Section 33 21 13.14.
- 8. Question: Who and when will it be determined which well(s) are going to receive acidization? Acid cannot be purchased in the Keys. Therefore, a sufficient amount needs to be transported to the work site during mobilization. Answer: If a well is to be acidized, this will be stated in the Work Order that is issued to the Contractor prior to mobilization. The Work Order will also specify the type of acid to be used.

- 9. Question: Section 33 21 13.14, page 6, states that the open borehole needs to be surged in 20' sections after chemical emplacement, and "this procedure" needs to be performed twice over a 48-hour period. Does "this procedure" refer to just the surging, or will acid be injected again and then surged again. Secondly, do we need to wait 48 hours to repeat procedure?

 Answer: The surging must be performed twice, not the injection of chemicals. The City may elect to reduce the wait time on a case-by-case basis; however bidders should base their bid on the requirements of the specifications.
- 10. Question: Would cable tool be an acceptable method for deepening the wells? Answer: Cable tool is an acceptable method for deepening the wells. City staff will verify the depth of each well after depth restoration and prior to airlifting regardless of the method used to remove debris.
- Question: Will there be any charges for discharging to the sanitary sewer system?Answer: No.
- 12. Question: Will standard procedure be to airlift develop the well, brush the well, then proceed with acidization? Please confirm. Answer: First, restore the depth of the well by removing accumulated sediment. This can be done by either drilling or airlifting. City staff will verify restoration of well depth. Next, brush the well if required by the Owner. Then, airlift the well for a minimum of 8 hours, or until the water is free from sand, silt, and turbidity (Section 33 21 13.14 3.02E). Note that the airlift development time could be less than 8 hours. If the airlift method is used to restore depth, the Contractor will not be paid under Line Item 5 (additional airlift development) for time spent airlifting the well to restore depth. Line Item 2 should reflect all costs for restoring the well depth (regardless of method) AND up to 8 hours of airlifting following depth restoration. If acidization is required, it will be performed following depth restoration and airlifting. Caliper logging may be required, the proposal (Section 00 41 13) has been modified to reflect this. If caliper logging is required, it will be included in the Work Order. Caliper logging will only be performed if required under the terms of the City's permit with FDEP. Please refer to the revised Section 33 21 13.14 Water Well Rehabilitation and to the new Section 33 21 13.04 Water Well Geophysical Logging.
