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-- James Thomas Gibson Arrest Narrative:

On Saturday, 04/06/2024 at approximately 1538 hours, I (Ofc. Howell) completed an area check of 2700 North Roosevelt Boulevard (Overseas Market) and discovered a well-known subject, through several law enforcement encounters as James Gibson, utilizing a Publix shopping cart. Gibson is well known to be a nuisance toward the community, have alcohol dependency issues, as well commit other miscellaneous crimes that corrupt the public sense of morals.

I encountered James T. Gibson (DOB: 11/05/1954, Arrestee) trespassing near the entrance/exit of Winn Dixie, within Overseas Market. As I stopped my patrol vehicle and exited, Gibson recognized me and quickly attempted to leave the immediate area as though he knew he was committing a crime. I clearly and concisely identified myself and Gibson continued walking away from me, toward North Roosevelt Boulevard. I eventually caught up to Gibson, instructed him to place the belongings he was carrying on the ground. I grabbed Gibson's right shoulder and left forearm in an attempt to gain compliance and place Gibson in custody. Gibson continuously refused to cease his actions and constantly attempted to pull away from me. I, again, clearly and concisely instructed Gibson to place his hands behind his back. Gibson continued to pull away from me. At one point, Gibson suddenly and swiftly turned toward me to purposefully face me. Gibson decisively pushed me away several times. I instructed Gibson to cease his behavior. Gibson ignored me and took an aggressive fighting stance. As I reached for Gibson's wrist/forearm with my right hand and my radio microphone with my left hand, Gibson struck me on the left side of my neck and face with a closed fist punch. Gibson's closed fist strike knocked off my sunglasses and temporarily stunned me, while temporarily blinding me. Gibson continued to maintain his aggressive fighting stance and scratched the right side of my head, near my forehead. Gibson then struck me on the left side of my neck and face, with a closed fist punch. Due to Gibson's actions and level of resistance rising, as well as the brief stunning and blinding I experienced, I struck Gibson with a closed fist in the head several times. I continued to strike Gibson until he stopped raising his arms in an attempt to continue his strikes and ceased to attempt to move toward me. After Gibson fell to the ground, I placed him in handcuffs and immediately moved him to the recovery position.

Due to his actions, Gibson received a small one inch to one-and-a-half-inch laceration to the back of his head. Gibson also received a small half-inch abrasion on his nose, as well as a small half-inch abrasion to his left elbow. Gibson refused treatment on scene from Fire/Rescue 3, reference run number: 24-001959 for further details. However, Gibson was transported to Lower Keys Medical Center for further medical evaluation and treatment. Gibson was treated and medically cleared by Dr. Jones. Sgt. Duponty took photographs of Gibson's injuries. I uploaded said photographs to Evidence.com.

Due to Gibson's actions, I received two small scratches on the right side of my head, near my forehead. One of the scratches was approximately two inches in length and the other was approximately two and a half inches in length. I also received swelling, or edema, to the left side of my neck and face to include my jaw and eyebrow, due to Gibson's actions. I was medically evaluated and received treatment on scene from Fire/Rescue 3, reference run number: 24-001959 for further details. Sgt. Duponty took photographs of my injuries. I uploaded said photographs to Evidence.com.

I researched Gibson's information. I searched Gibson subsequent to arrest and walked him to my patrol vehicle after his medical clearance.

I transported Gibson to Monroe County Detention Center, without incident.

Gibson was arrested for trespassing at 2700 North Roosevelt Boulevard on 02/12/2024 at approximately 1559 hours,

Gibson was arrested for trespassing at 2700 North Roosevelt Boulevard on 12/16/2023 at approximately 0721 hours, reference CASE number: 23-006789 for further information. Gibson was issued a trespass warning for 2700 North Roosevelt Boulevard on 10/20/2023 at approximately 0653 hours by Ofc. Johnson, reference CAD number: 232930040 for further information.

Based on the facts and evidence, I believe there is probable cause that on 04/06/2024, James T. Gibson did knowingly and intentionally violate F.S.S. 784.07-2B Battery On LEO/Firefighter/EMT, by actually and purposely striking me with a close fist at least twice on the left side of my neck/head and scratching me at least twice on the right side of my head, while I was engaged in my legal, lawful duties as a uniformed law enforcement officer.

Based on the facts and evidence, I believe there is probable cause that on 04/06/2024, James T. Gibson did knowingly and intentionally violate F.S.S. 843.01 Resisting with Violence, by willingly and purposely attempting to physically struggle while pulling away from me as well as punching me and scratching me several times, as I detained him while I engaged in my legal, lawful duties as a uniformed law enforcement officer.

Based on the facts and evidence, I believe there is probable cause that on 04/06/2024, James T. Gibson did knowingly and intentionally violate F.S.S. 810.09-1A1 Trespass on Property Other Than Structure or Conveyance, by actually and purposefully remaining on the premises and refusing to leave the property, after being warned by clearly marked and visible signage as well as multiple warnings from law enforcement officers.

After reviewing my BWC, I realized that my BWC malfunctioned and did not capture the entire incident. Gibson attempting to flee, Gibson attempting to pull away from me and push me several times, and Gibson striking me with a closed fist at least twice as well as my response to resistance was not captured on my BWC. The video began after the use of force incident as multiple passersby engaged with me in an attempt to intervene and/or obstruct my capabilities to render first aid to Gibson. Within the video that was captured, it can be seen that I have Gibson handcuffed, and placed in the recovery position, as multiple subjects who had no involvement in the incident distracted me and took my attention away from Gibson. At one point, I realized that I was completely surrounded by at least seven passersby and had several subjects attempting to distract me. I felt as though some of the passersby may have presented a potential threat, as at least one said passersby was a subject I had several previous law enforcement encounters with. Within the video that was captured, it can be seen that I am attempting to tell two of the subjects to "back up" and "go away." It can also be seen in the video that was captured that I instruct several subjects to stop impeding by investigation and to go back inside.

It is important to note that one of the subjects that had no involvement with the incident, that also initially distracted me, recorded my response to resistance with their cellular phone and immediately posted a video on social media. I obtained a copy of said video and uploaded it to Evidence.com Within the video, Gibson can be seen pulling away from me, striking me with a closed fist at least twice on the left side of my neck/head, scratching the right side of my head, and my response to resistance.

Gibson appeared to be under the influence of alcohol. Gibson`s speech was slurred, and his eyes were bloodshot and glossy. Gibson`s breath had the odor of alcoholic intoxicants.

My BWC was activated for the encounter, arrest, and subsequent search of Gibson. My FLEET Axon was activated for the transport of Gibson to Monroe County Detention Center. I uploaded the videos to Evidence.com.

On Saturday, April 6, 2024 I (Ofc. M. Calvert) heard Ofc. Howell call out with a "77" at Overseas Market, and in just clearing a call on Smather's Beach I went en-route as a back-up unit.

While en-route, I heard Ofc. Howell, sounding disheveled on the radio, requesting a supervisor and mentioning something about a punch in the face. At this point I was close by, and arrived shortly after with Ofc. T. Clark right behind me. Ofc. Clark and I located Ofc. Howell in front of Goldman's standing near a male in a yellow hooded sweatshirt, who was laying to his right and bleeding from an unknown location on the right side of the head. The male was known to Ofc. Howell as a trespasser and stated his last name was Gibson.

People were coming out from Goldman's Deli and we asked that they step back, and advised Ofc. Howell to walk away and check his injuries, as he had swelling on the left side of his face.

I requested KWFR to respond, when both Sgts were en-route.

The Goldman's employees/owners were starting to tell me what they saw, some captured on my BWC, and I directed them to give their eye witness accounts to Sgt. Sims.

A Hispanic male who was collecting shopping carts for Winn-Dixie stated (via translation) that Gibson had been over near Winn-Dixie and got up and left his food when the Officer came. He did not want to be involved any further.

My Axon BWC was uploaded.

I had no further involvement.

On Saturday, 04/06/24, at approximately 1545hrs, I (Ofc. T. Clark), responded to 2700 N. Roosevelt Blvd, Jersey Mikes, in reference to an officer assist.

Ofc. W. Howell had just advised over KWPD Comm1 that he had been punched in the face.

BWC activated

On arrival, I saw a handcuffed white male, known to me from previous contacts as, James Gibson. Gibson is known to me to have been trespass warned and arrested for trespassing at the plaza.

Gibson was laying on his right side, and was bleeding from the right side of his head. Gibson was conscious, alert and breathing. I helped Gibson to a seated position.

Ofc. Howell appeared to have redness and swelling to the left side of his face. Ofc. Howell was in full KWPD uniform with badge displayed.

EMS arrived on scene to treat Gibsons injuries.

I road with EMS as they transported Gibson to the LKMC ER. Gibson was very talkative and telling jokes.

At the ER (BWC not activated to protect patient privacy), Gibson received treatment for a laceration to the right side of his head.

Gibson made numerous utterances without questioning. Gibson told me Ofc. Howell walked up behind him and told him to put his hands behind his back. Gibson said Ofc. Howell had no constitutional authority to do so, without telling him what he did wrong first. Gibson said Ofc. Howell grabbed his hand after and Gibson was not legally allowed to be touched so he punched Ofc. Howell.

I then left, as Gibson was taken for further examinations.
