Subject: **Approving Task Order for Charley Toppino and Sons, Inc to rehabilitate 7 stormwater wells under the General Utilities contract as approved under resolution 25-103 (File ID 25-4169)**

Introduction

Staff are requesting that the City Commission approve a Task Order from Charley Toppino and Sons, Inc. (CTS), to rehabilitate 7 stormwater wells under the General Utilities Contract approved by Resolution 25-103 in the amount of \$196,350.00 (7@\$28,050).

Background

The City owns and operates 92 Stormwater injection wells as part of the City's stormwater collection system. Over time sediment and debris deposits diminish well capacity, which in turn reduces the system design efficiency. To ensure our collection system operates as designed these wells require periodic cleaning or "rehabilitation".

Utilities will identify wells that are "underperforming" and have them rehabilitated, as budget allows, as part of an ongoing maintenance effort. Authorizing this Task Order will approve the following 7 wells for rehabilitation:

- 1801 Atlantic Pump Station
- Patricia & Ashby Pump Station
- George St Pump Station (2 wells)
- Catherine & Thomas (Gravity)
- Angela & Simonton (Gravity)
- 20th & Duck (Gravity)

Financial

Funds for Stormwater Well Rehabilitation have been and will be annually budgeted in Stormwater Construction/Repair and Maintenance Account Number 402-3802-538-4600.

Recommendation

Staff recommend that City Commission approve Task Order from Charley Toppino and Sons Inc in the amount of \$196,350.00, for rehabilitation of the above listed 7 Stormwater Wells.
