Subject: **File ID 26-5093 Accepting recommendation of Res SAB 26-01; Adopting City of Key West Comprehensive Safety Action Plan**

Introduction

Staff recommends that the City Commission approve the recommendation of the Sustainability Advisory Board (Res SAB 26-01) which adopts the City of Key West Comprehensive Safety Action Plan.

Background

The City of Key West received (80/20) grant funding from the Federal Highway Administration to create a safety action plan in support of its “Vision Zero” goal to eliminate roadway fatalities and serious injuries by 2035. A safety action plan provides a roadmap for reducing injuries and provides the City with additional opportunities to receive federal grant funding for the implementation of proven safety countermeasures.

University of Florida Transportation Institute investigators worked with representatives of local police, EMS, and transportation; Monroe County schools and transportation; Florida Department of Transportation; and community advocates to evaluate proven safety countermeasures and prioritize policies and projects for the City.

The Sustainability Advisory Board passed Resolution 26-01 supporting and recommending the City of Key West Comprehensive Safety Action Plan.

Procurement

There is no cost to support the Safety Action Plan, but implementing projects will likely require cost share.

Recommendation

The City Manager’s Office recommends the Mayor and City Commission accept the recommendation of the Sustainability Advisory Board and approve the resolution adopting the City of Key West Comprehensive Safety Action Plan.
