A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE FLAGLER CENTENNIAL COMMITTEE AND THE MARKET SHARE COMPANY TO CONDUCT THE CENTENNIAL OF THE FLAGLER RAILROAD ROLLING PARADE ON DUVAL STREET FROM 11:00 A.M. TO 4:00 P.M. SUNDAY, JANUARY 22, 2012; AUTHORIZING THE CLOSURE OF CERTAIN STREETS OR PORTIONS THEREOF FOR SAID PARADE FROM 11:00 A.M. TO 4:00 P.M.; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Commission of the City of Key West, Florida, as follows:

Section 1. That the Flagler Centennial Committee and Market Share Company is hereby granted permission to hold a Centennial of the Flagler Railroad rolling parade starting at the Truman Waterfront taking a right at Whitehead Street, a left onto Angela Street, a left on Duval, a left on Front and ending back to the Truman Waterfront from 11:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Sunday, January 22, 2012, and the City will close portions thereof from 11:00 a.m. to approximately 4:00 p.m. for said parade.

Section 2. That any use of the Truman Waterfront properties should be coordinated and approved through the Local Redevelopment Agency Office.

Section 3. That Flagler Centennial Committee and Market Share Company will

adhere to the recycling plan of the City of Key West, that (1) recycling container for every one (1) trash barrels will be used and that they will be placed side by side.

Section 4. That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signatures of the presiding officers and Clerk of the Commission.
