
PART 1: BIDDING REQUIREMENTS

INVITATION TO BID

Sealed bids for RIGHT OF WAY IMPROVEMENTS 2022 / ITB 22-010 addressed to the City of Key West, will be received at the Office of the City Clerk, 1300 White Street., Key West Florida, until 3:00 p.m., local time, on 11/16/2022 and then will be publicly opened and read. Any bids received after the time and date specified will not be considered.

Please submit one (1) original and two (2) USB drives with a single PDF file of the entire bid proposal package, electronic copies of blank or incomplete documents will be deemed non-responsive. Bid package shall be enclosed in a sealed envelope clearly marked on the outside "ITB 22-010: RIGHT OF WAY IMPROVEMENTS 2022"; addressed and delivered to the City Clerk's office at the address noted above.

The proposed contract generally consists of work within the City's RIGHTS OF WAY including asphalt paving, sidewalk construction, signage, pavement markings, utility trench repair and shoulder restoration as directed by the City.

A non-mandatory pre-bid meeting will be held at 11:00 am on October 19, 2022 in the City Manager's conference room, 2nd floor, Key West City Hall, 1300 White Street, Key West, Florida.

The successful Bidder will be required to furnish the necessary additional bond(s) for the faithful performance of the Contract, as Prescribed in the Bidding Documents. Within 10 days after the Notice of Award, the successful Bidder will also be required to furnish documentation showing that they are in compliance with the licensing requirements of the State and that the Provisions of Chapter 66 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Key West. Compliance with these Provisions is required before the CONTRACTOR can enter into the agreement contained in the Contract Documents.

EACH BID MUST BE SUBMITTED ON THE PRESCRIBED FORM AND ACCOMPANIED BY BID SECURITY AS PRESCRIBED IN THE INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS, PAYABLE TO THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, IN AN AMOUNT NOT LESS THAN FIVE (5) PERCENT OF THE AMOUNT BID.

THE BIDDER MUST BE A LICENSED CONTRACTOR BY THE STATE OF FLORIDA AND SUBMIT PROOF OF SUCH WITH THE BID.

The Bidder shall furnish documentation showing that they are in compliance with the licensing requirements of the provisions of Chapter 66 Section 87 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Key West; within 10 days the following the Notice of Award and must demonstrate that they hold at a minimum, the following licenses & certificates;

- A. City of Key West Business Tax License Receipt
- B. A valid Certificate of Competency issued by the Chief Building Official of Key West, Florida.

All bid bonds, contract bonds, insurance contracts, and certificates of insurance shall be either executed by or countersigned by a licensed resident agent of the Surety or Insurance Company having his place of business in the State of Florida, and in all ways complying with the insurance laws of the State of Florida. Further, the said Surety or Insurance Company shall be duly licensed and qualified to do business in the State of Florida.

Before a Contract will be awarded for the work contemplated herein, the OWNER will conduct such investigation as is necessary to determine the performance record and ability of the apparent low Bidder to perform the size and type of work specified under this Contract. Upon request, the Bidder shall submit such information as deemed necessary by the OWNER to evaluate the Bidder's qualifications.

At the time of the award, the successful Bidder must show satisfactory documents of such State, County, and City licenses as would be required. Any permit and/or license requirement and subsequent costs are located within the bid documents. The successful Bidder must also be able to satisfy the City Attorney as to such insurance coverage and legal requirements as may be demanded by the Bid in question. The City may reject bids for any and/or all of the following reasons: (1) for budgetary reasons, (2) if the bidder misstates or conceals a material fact in its bid, (3) if the bid does not strictly conform to the law or is non-responsive to the bid requirements, (4) if the bid is conditional, (5) if a change of circumstances occurs making the purpose of the bid unnecessary to the City, or (6) if such rejection is in the best interest of the City. The City may also waive any minor formalities or irregularities in any bid.

The Owner reserves the right to award contracts to multiple bidders (maximum of two) as necessary to meet required work schedules as determined by the City.

INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS

1. CONTRACT DOCUMENTS

A. FORMAT

The Contract Documents are divided into parts, divisions, and sections for convenient organization and reference. Generally, there has been no attempt to divide the Specification sections into work performed by the various building trades, work by separate SUBCONTRACTOR work required for separate facilities in the Project.

B. DOCUMENT INTERPRETATION

The separate sections contained within these Contract Documents are intended to be mutually cooperative and to provide all details reasonably required for the execution of the proposed work.

Should there be any doubt as to the meaning or intent of said Contract Documents, the Bidder should request of the ENGINEER, in writing (at least eight (8) calendar days prior to the Bid opening) an interpretation thereof. Any interpretation or change in said Contract Documents will be made only in writing, in the form of addenda to the Documents which will become available to all registered holders of Bidding Documents. Bidders shall submit with their BIDS, or indicate receipt of, all Addenda. The OWNER will not be responsible for any other explanation or interpretations of said Documents.

2. GENERAL DESCRIPTION OF THE PROJECT

A general description of the work to be done is contained in the Invitation to Bid and the scope is specified in applicable parts of these Contract Documents.

3. QUALIFICATION OF CONTRACTORS

The Prospective Bidders must meet the statutorily prescribed requirements before award of the Contract by the OWNER.

4. BIDDER'S UNDERSTANDING

Each Bidder must inform himself of the conditions relating to the execution of the work and make himself thoroughly familiar with all the Contract Documents. Failure to do so will not relieve the successful Bidder of his obligation to enter into a Contract and complete the contemplated work in strict accordance with the Contract Documents. Each Bidder shall inform himself of, and the Bidder awarded a Contract shall comply with, federal, state, and local laws, statutes, and ordinances relative to the work. This requirement includes, but is not limited to, regulations concerning minimum wage rates, nondiscrimination in the employment of labor, protection of public and employee safety and health, environmental protection, natural resource protection, fire protection, burning and non-burning requirements, permits, fees, and similar subjects.

5. TYPE OF BID

A. UNIT PRICE

The bid for the work is to be submitted on a Unit Price basis. Unit prices shall be submitted in all appropriate places in the Bid Proposal Form.

6. PREPARATION OF BIDS

A. GENERAL

All blank spaces in the Bid form must be filled in, as required, in BLACK INK. All Price information will be shown in figures where required. No changes shall be made in the phraseology of the forms.

Any Bid shall be deemed informal which contains omissions erasures, alterations, or additions of any kind, or Prices uncalled for, or in which any of the Prices are obviously unbalanced, or which in any manner shall fail to conform to the conditions of the published Invitation to Bid.

Only one Bid from any individual, firm, partnership, or corporation under the same or different names will be considered. Should it appear to the OWNER that any Bidder is interested in more than one Bid for work contemplated, all Bids in which such Bidder is interested will be rejected.

B. SIGNATURE

The Bidder shall sign his Bid in the blank space provided therefore. If Bidder is a corporation, the legal name of the corporation shall be set forth above, together with the signature of the officer or officers authorized to sign Contracts on behalf of the corporation. If the Bidder is a partnership, the true name of the firm shall be set forth above, together with the signature of the partner or partners authorized to sign Contracts on behalf of the partnership. If signature is by an agent, other than an officer of a corporation or a member of a partnership, a notarized power of attorney must be on file with the OWNER Prior to opening of Bids or submitted with the Bid, otherwise the Bid will be regarded as not properly authorized.

C. SPECIAL BIDDING REQUIREMENTS

The Bidder's attention is brought to the hiring Practices and licenses and permits of the City of Key West. These are defined in the addition to Article 39, ORDINANCES, PERMITS, AND LICENSES, as set forth in the Supplementary Conditions.

The Bidder shall submit with his Bid his experience record showing their experience and expertise in RIGHT OF WAY improvement work. Such experience record shall provide at least five (5) current or recent Projects (within the last 5 years) of similar work, preferably within Florida or the Southeastern United States.

The following information will be provided:

2. Contract amount
3. Dates work was performed
4. OWNER
5. Name of OWNER's contact person and phone number

E. PUBLIC ENTITY CRIMES FORM

Pursuant to the requirements of Chapter 287.133, Laws of Florida, pertaining to the sworn statement on Public Entity Crimes and the Convicted Vendor List, all Bidders shall submit a signed and notarized statement with their Bid on the form provided herein.

7. STATE AND LOCAL SALES AND USE TAXES

Unless the Supplementary Conditions contains a statement that the OWNER is exempt from state sales tax on materials incorporated into the work due to the qualification of the work under this Contract, the CONTRACTOR, as required by the laws and statutes of the state and its political subdivisions, shall pay all state and local sales and use taxes. Prices quoted in the Bid shall include all nonexempt sales and use taxes, unless Provision is made in the Bid form to separately itemize the tax.

8. SUBMISSION OF BID PROPOSALS

All Bids must be submitted not later than the time prescribed, at the place, and in the manner set forth in the Invitation to Bid. Bids must be made on the Bid Proposal forms provided herewith, submit one (1) original and two (2) USB drives each with a single file of the entire bid proposal package.

Each Bid must be submitted in a sealed envelope, so marked as to indicate the Bidder's name and

its contents without being opened and addressed in conformance with the instructions in the Invitation to Bid.

9. MODIFICATION OR WITHDRAWAL OF BID PROPOSALS

Prior to the time and date designated for receipt of Bids, any Bid submitted may be modified or withdrawn by notice to the party receiving Bids at the place designated for the receipt of Bids. Such notice shall be in writing over the signature of the Bidder or by email. If by email, written confirmation over the signature of the Bidder shall be mailed and postmarked on or before the date and time set for receipt of Bids, and it shall be so worded as not to reveal the amount of the original Bid. No Bid may be withdrawn after the time scheduled for the opening of Bids, unless the time specified in paragraph AWARD OF CONTRACT of these Instructions to Bidders shall have elapsed.

10. BID SECURITY

Bids must be accompanied by a certified check drawn on a bank in good standing, or a Bid Bond issued by a Surety authorized to issue such bonds in the state where the work is located, in the amount of five (5) percent of the total amount of the Bid submitted. This Bid security shall be given as a guarantee that the Bidder will not withdraw his Bid for a period of Sixty (60) days after Bid opening, and that if awarded the Contract, the successful Bidder will execute the attached Contract and furnish properly executed performance and payment bonds, each in the full amount of the contract price, within the time specified. Agent and surety phone numbers must be provided.

The attorney-in-Fact who executes this bond in behalf of the Surety must attach a notarized copy of his power-of-attorney as evidence of his authority to bind the Surety on the date of the execution of the bond. Where State Statute requires, certification by a resident agent shall also be provided.

If the Bidder elects to furnish a Bid Bond, he shall use the Bid Bond form bound herewith, or one conforming substantially thereto in form and content.

11. RETURN OF BID SECURITY

Within fifteen (15) days after the award of the Contract, the City will return the Bid securities to all Bidders whose Bids are not to be further considered in awarding the Contract. Retained Bid securities will be held until the Contract(s) has been finally executed, after which all Bid securities, other than Bidder's Bonds and any guarantees which have been forfeited, will be returned to the respective Bidders whose Bids they accompanied.

12. AWARD OF CONTRACT

Within sixty (60) calendar days after the opening of the Bids, the City will accept up to two of the Bids. The acceptance of the Bid(s) will be by written notice of award, mailed to the office designated in the Bid, or delivered to the Bidder's representative. In the event of failure of the lowest responsive Bidder(s) to sign the Contract and provide acceptable insurance certificate(s) and acceptable performance and payment bonds, and evidence of holding required licenses, the

City may award the Contract to the next lowest, responsive, responsible Bidder.

The City reserves the right to accept or reject any and all Bids, and to waive any informalities and irregularities in said Bids.

13. BASIS OF AWARD

The award will be made by the City, on the basis of the Total of Base Bid Items found on the Bid Proposal Form from the lowest responsive, responsible Bidder(s), which in the City's sole and absolute judgment, will serve the best interests of the City. Quantities shown on the Bid Proposal Form represent an estimate of the total annual work performed under this contract and is not a guarantee of work to be granted by OWNER to CONTRACTOR. **The OWNER reserves the right to award contracts to multiple bidders (maximum of two) as necessary to meet required work schedules as determined by the City.**

In considering the acceptance of multiple bids, the City will make its determination based on the following criteria:

- The 2nd lowest responsible bid will not be accepted if the bid exceeds 25% of the lowest responsible bidder's **total contract price**.

If at the time this Contract is to be awarded, the total of the lowest acceptable Bids exceed the funds then estimated by the City as available, the City may reject all Bids or take such other action as best serves the City's interest.

14. EXECUTION OF CONTRACT

The successful Bidder(s) shall, within ten (10) working days after receiving Notice of Award, sign and deliver to the City a Contract and two (2) copies in the form hereto attached together with the acceptable insurance certificates, bonds, and evidence of the holding required licenses as required in these Documents. Within ten (10) working days after receiving the signed Contract from the successful Bidder(s), the City's authorized agent will sign the Contract. Signature by both parties constitutes execution of the Contract.

15. CONTRACT BONDS

A. PERFORMANCE AND PAYMENT BONDS

The successful Bidders shall file with the City, at the time of delivery of each individual signed Work Order a Performance Bond and Payment Bond on the forms bound herewith, each in the full amount of the Contract Price in accordance with the requirements of Florida Statutes Section 255.05 or 713.23, as applicable, as security for the faithful performance of the Contract and the payment of all persons supplying labor and materials for the construction of the work, and to cover all guarantees against defective workmanship or materials, or both, during the warranty period following the date of final acceptance of the work by the City.

The Surety furnishing this bond shall have a sound financial standing and a record of service satisfactory to the City, shall be authorized to do business in the State of Florida, and shall be listed on the current U.S. Department of Treasury Circular Number 570, or amendments thereto in the Federal Register, of acceptable Sureties for federal Projects. Section 255.05(7), Florida Statutes, in lieu of the bond required by law, the CONTRACTOR may file with the city an alternative form of security in the form of cash, a money order, a certified check, a cashier's check or an irrevocable letter of credit.

B. POWER-OF-ATTORNEY

The Attorney-in-Fact (Resident Agent) who executes Performance and Payment Bonds on behalf of the Surety must attach a notarized copy of his power-of-attorney as evidence of his authority to bind the Surety on the date of execution of the bond. Performance and Payment Bonds, and respective powers-of-attorney will have the same date.

16. FAILURE TO EXECUTE CONTRACT AND FURNISH BOND

The Bidder(s) who has a Contract awarded to him and who fails to promptly and properly execute the Contract or furnish the required Bonds shall forfeit the bid security that accompanied his bid, and the bid security shall be retained as liquidated damages by the City, and it is agreed that this said sum is a fair estimate of the amount of damages the City will sustain in case the Bidders fail to enter into a Contract or furnish the required Bonds. Bid security deposited in the form of cash, a certified check, or cashier's check shall be subject to the same requirement as a Bid Bond.

17. PERFORMANCE OF WORK BY SUBCONTRACTOR

Each Bidder must furnish with his proposal a list of SUBCONTRACTOR performed items and the estimated value of each item.

18. TIME OF COMPLETION

The time of completion of the work to be performed under this Contract is the essence of the Contract. Delays and extensions of time may be allowed in accordance with the Provisions stated in the General Conditions. Work Orders will be issued by ENGINEER as a means to track time & materials for work performed in the referenced right of way. A time estimate for the completion of each work order will be stated in that particular Work Order; when the CONTRACTOR receives a Work Order, work shall commence as soon as possible and all work shall be completed within the number of calendar days stipulated in that particular Work Order.

On any individual Work Order request, if the CONTRACTOR cannot commit to completing the work within the City's specified time of completion, the City reserves the right cancel the work order request and enter into a separate work order with another contracting firm selected through this bid. Should the CONTRACTOR disagree with the time of completion for a specific Work Order, he shall, within five (5) calendar days of the receipt of the Work Order, make a written claim to the ENGINEER and City for an extension in the time of completion. If in the opinion of the ENGINEER

and City, the CONTRACTOR presents sufficient evidence to justify the claim, an extension in the time of completion will be allowed for the period determined by the ENGINEER and City.

Should a Work Order extend past the one (1) year contract period for unforeseen reasons the work shall be automatically extended to the date of completion not to exceed 90 days.

BIDDER'S DECLARATION AND UNDERSTANDING

The undersigned, hereinafter called the Bidder, declares that the only persons or parties interested in this Bid are those named herein, that this Bid is, in all respects, fair and without fraud, that it is made without collusion with any official of the City, and that the Bid is made without any connection or collusion with any person submitting another Bid on this Contract.

The Bidder further declares that he has carefully examined the Contract Documents for the construction of the Project, that he has satisfied himself as to the work involved, including materials and equipment, and conditions of work, including the fact that the description of the quantities of work and materials, as included herein, is brief and is intended only to indicate the general nature of the work and to identify the said quantities with the detailed requirements of the Contract Documents, and that this Bid is made according to the Provisions and under the terms of the Contract Documents, which Documents are hereby made a part of this Bid.

The Bidder further agrees that he has exercised his own judgment regarding the interpretation of subsurface information and has utilized all data which he believes pertinent from the ENGINEER, City, and other sources in arriving at his conclusions.

CONTRACT EXECUTION AND BONDS

The Bidder agrees that if this Bid is accepted, he will, within 10 days after Notice of Award, sign the Contract in the form annexed hereto, and will at that time, deliver to the City examples of the Performance Bond and Payment Bond required herein, and evidence of holding required licenses and certificates, and will, to the extent of his Bid, furnish all machinery, tool, apparatus, and other means of

construction and do the work and furnish all the materials necessary to complete all work as specified or indicated in the Contract Documents.

CERTIFICATES OF INSURANCE

Bidder agrees to furnish the City, before commencing the work under this Contract, the certificates of insurance as specified in these Documents.

START OF CONSTRUCTION AND CONTRACT COMPLETION TIME

The Bidder further agrees to begin work within 10 calendar days after the date of the Notice to Proceed and to complete the construction, in all respects, within the number of calendar days set forth in each Work Order.

This Contract will automatically expire and be terminated two (2) year after the date of the execution of the Contract by the City unless granted a one-year contract extension at the discretion of the City.

LIQUIDATED DAMAGES

In the event the Bidder is awarded the Contract and shall fail to complete the work authorized by a particular Work Order within the time limit or extended time limit agreed upon in that Work Order, as more particularly set forth in the Contract Documents, liquidated damages shall be paid to the City at the rate of \$500 per day for all work authorized under said Work Order until the work shall have been satisfactorily completed as provided by the Contract Documents. Sundays and legal holidays shall be included in determining days in default.

ADDENDA

The Bidder hereby acknowledges that he has received Addenda Nos'. 1, _____, _____, _____, _____ (Bidder shall insert the number of each Addendum received) and agrees that all addenda issued are hereby made part of the Contract Documents, and the Bidder further agrees that his Bid(s) includes all impacts resulting from said Addenda.

SALES AND USE TAXES

The Bidder agrees that all federal, state, and local sales and use taxes are included in the stated bid Prices for the work.

ESTIMATED QUANTITIES

Estimated Quantities in Bid Proposal Form are provided for Bid comparison purposes. Work will be performed on a unit price basis and actual quantities for payment may vary significantly.
