On Friday, 10/29/21, at approximately 2333 hrs, Ofc. M. Chaustit (see supplemental) and I (Ofc. T. Clark), while on foot patrol of 210 Duval St, observed a subject attempting to fight another.

We were both wearing full KWPD uniforms.

\*\*\*BWC later activated\*\*\*

The subject, later identified by his NY DL as, Marcelo Gonzalez 04/09/00, was attempting to fight another unknown male in our presence. The subject was throwing his chest out inciting a fight and closing the distance between the unknown male.

Ofc. Chaustit gave Marcelo lawful commands to back away in order to maintain the peace. Marcelo ignored Ofc. Chaustit. Ofc. Chaustit attempted to detain Marcelo. I saw Marcelo pull away from my fellow Officer's grasp during the lawful performance of his duties.

Marcelo pulled away. Marcelo exhibited slurred speech, glassy/watery/bloodshot eyes and the odor of an alcoholic beverage on his breath.

I attempted to grab Marcelo's right wrist and he twisted/pulled away from my grasp. Marcelo ignored lawful commands to place his hands behind his back.

Ofc. Chaustit and I redirected Marcelo up against the building as we wrestled his arms behind his back and placed him under arrest. Marcelo did not suffer any visible injuries from the redirection. Marcelo did not complain of any injuries.

Sgt. J. Stockton, later responded to complete a Response to Resistance Incident Report.

Due to the totality of the circumstances, I found probable cause to charge Marcelo with resisting without violence, FSS 843.02. Marcelo did, twist and pull away from our grasps, during a lawful arrest, in attempts to free himself from custody.

Marcelo was booked at 510 Greene St.

On October 29, 2021, I was working at the intersection of Duval Street and Charles Street. At about 2333 hours, I was flagged down about someone attempting to start a fight about 20 to 30 feet south of my location.

I turned to see who was involved and I saw a male, later identified as Marcelo Gonzalez, squared off with another male. Gonzalez had his fists clenched and kept repeating "Pussy. Lets go pussy." As I approached, the male Gonzalez was attempting to fight was walking backwards away from Gonzalez, then turned around and walked away.

I made contact with Gonzalez as he was the aggressor and attempting to start a fight. Gonzalez put his hands up and said "sorry sorry." I grabbed onto Gonzalez's left hand and wrist to take him into custody. Gonzalez pulled away and twisted his body attempting to free himself from my grip. Ofc. Clark and I both told Gonzalez not to pull way, however, he continued to pull away from Ofc. Clark and I. I utilized a wrist lock and to pushed Gonzalez into a wall to gain control of him. Ofc. Clark and I both told Gonzalez to stop resisting and it was over. Gonzalez was handcuffed and we walked him from Duval Street to 510 Greene Street for processing. While walking to 510 Greene Street Gonzalez continued to twist and pull away, but Ofc. Clark and I maintained control of him. We arrived at 510 Greene Street and MCSO Deputies transported Gonzalez to the detention center.

On Saturday, 10/30/21, at approximately 0142hrs, I (Ofc. T. Clark), responded to 5501 College Rd, Monroe County Detention Facility, in reference to a follow up on KWPD 21-6061. This incident would become a narcotics investigation.

Earlier, I had placed a white male subject, identified by NY DL as, Marcelo Gonzalez 04/09/00, under arrest for resisting without violence.

Marcelo, attempted to fight another subject at 210 Duval St and resisted attempts to place him under lawful arrest.

Marcelo was walked to 510 Greene St. Marcelo was provided an opportunity to declare any contraband at the booking area by Corrections Deputies on scene.

Marcelo did not declare any contraband.

Marcelo was transported to jail by MCSO. Once in intake at jail, D/S Jefferson located a small orange, clear plastic baggie containing a white powdery substance (later FTP Cocaine), in a small slit in Marcelo's wallet.

I was notified and responded to the jail where I took possession of the suspected narcotic. I activated my BWC and tested the substance. It showed field test presumptive for cocaine.

Due to the totality of the circumstances, I found probable cause to charge Marcelo with possession of cocaine, FSS 893.13(6)(a), for the FTP cocaine located in his wallet after lawful arrest. I also found probable cause to charge Marcelo with Introduction of contraband in a detention facility, FSS 951.22(1), for introducing FTP cocaine, into the jail after being provided with an opportunity to disclose it.
