A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, APPROVING AN AMENDMENT TO ARTICLE 2 OF THE COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF KEY WEST AND TEAMSTERS LOCAL 769, OFFICE AND BLUE COLLAR WORKERS, EFFECTIVE OCTOBER 1, 2014 THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30, 2017; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, City staff recommends an amendment to Article 2 of the Teamsters Local 769 Collective Bargaining Agreement to clarify that Teamsters Local Union No. 769 is the sole and exclusive bargaining agent for job classifications set forth in PERC Certification 241 and PERC Certification 526;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That Article 2 of the attached collective bargaining agreement between the City Of Key West and Teamsters Local 769, Office and Blue Collar Workers, is hereby amended as follows (added text is <u>underlined</u> and deleted text is <u>struck</u> through):

## ARTICLE 2 RECOGNITION

The City of Key West recognizes Teamsters Local Union No. 769, affiliated with the International Brotherhood of Teamsters, as the sole and exclusive bargaining agent for the job classifications in the unit designated by the Florida Public Employee Relations Commission, as clarified by PERC case #UC-88-035, dated 9/11/89 Certification 241 and Certification 526, excluding all other Employees.

Section 2: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the Presiding Officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
