A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING PURSUANT TO SECTION 2-771(c) OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES THE DISPOSAL OF SEVEN (7) CITY-OWNED VEHICLES; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, seven City-owned vehicles are surplus and obsolete, and City staff recommends disposal of the vehicles through a bulk sale (one transaction), to the highest bidder, with a certificate of disposal or salvage-only title; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the disposal of seven (7) vehicles, as described in the attached executive summary dated January 13, 2015, is hereby approved.

Section 2: That the seven (7) vehicles shall be sold as one bulk sale, with certificates of disposal or salvage-only titles, to the highest bidder.

Section 3: That the City Manager, upon advice and consent of the City Attorney, is authorized to execute all necessary documents to complete the transaction.

Section 4: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the presiding officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
