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-- Michael Anthony Poole Arrest Narrative:

On Saturday, March 16, 2024, at 1953 hours, I (Ofc Andrade) responded to The Southernmost Beach Resort, 1319 Duval St, reference a man hitting a woman.

On arrival I saw a male (later identified as Michael Anthony Poole, DOB 12/20/1972 of WY) matching the description provided by Key West Communications Channel One of a white bald male wearing a green shirt, seated on the ground with two men holding Michael's hands behind his back. I immediately placed Michael into handcuffs while the two men informed me that Michael was the person who had struck a female.

I stood directly behind Michael, bracing him at the back with my right leg, so he wouldn't fall because at this time he was letting his body go limp. Michael had the strong smell of alcohol emanating from his person. I could see that Michael had an abrasion to his left shoulder, and on his right shin. I asked Michael if he was here with anyone and his name as I looked over his left shoulder. Although I couldn't fully see his face at this time, Michael appeared to have blood on his face, but I could not see where it was coming from.

Michael remained quiet and I stood Michael up having to exert great effort, as he was reluctant to do so. I then walked Michael over to my patrol car and placed him against it, with him facing the car. I began to search Michael's person; he then began to push back against me. I told Michael to stop but instead he pushed his weight against me with greater force. I pushed Michael against my patrol car again and this time Michael attempted to face me by rotating his torso to his right while trying to free himself from my grasp. Next to my patrol car was a short retaining wall with several plants, and a palm tree. I redirected Michael to face the retaining wall and I pushed him against the retaining wall and palm tree, all the while ordering him to stop. Michael continued his efforts to face me and free himself from my grasp. In doing so I redirected Michael back towards my patrol car. Once facing my patrol car Micheal was able to tense his body as he pushed back against me while again trying to spin to his right to face me. I redirected Michael to the ground. In doing so Michael suffered a contusion to the right side of his face. I put Michael in the recovery position, with his right side contacting the ground. I then called for Key West Rescue.

At this time Ofc Young arrived on scene and assisted in holding Michael down who was moving attempting to get up. I then walked over and spoke with a witness, Joell C Adams, DOB 01/09/1970 of OH, who told me the following:

She was with her son (later identified as Ulysses Samual Adams, DOB 06/08/2005 of OH, in the parking lot waiting for their ride. They heard someone yelling obscenities, then they saw Michael who had blood on his face. Ulysses asked Michael if he was okay and if he had been in a fight. Michael aggressively approached them and punched Joell in the right side of her face and in the back of her head. Ulysses then came to the defense of his mother. I also spoke with Ulysses who added that he punched Michael in the face after Michael struck his mother. Michael fell to the ground but got up and attacked Joell again. Michael punched Ulysses on the right side of his face and Ulysses punched back in self-defense. Ulysses continually attempted to keep his distance, but Michael kept tracking his movements. People began to gather around, and Ulysses believed this would make Michael stop fighting but he continued his attacks.

I also spoke with another victim, Charolette Ledger, DOB 12/14/1986, of the United Kingdom, who told me the following:

She walked out from the pool area to the parking lot where she encountered Michael who was screaming obscenities

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and kicking bicycles in the bike rack. Concerned, Charolette addressed Michael and he then aggressively approached her while saying, "Fuck you, fuck you. This is America." Michael then proceeded to punch her in the head several times, knocking her to the ground. Micheal then grabbed her by her hair and drug her while she was on her back. An employee came out to the parking lot and Michael released her. Charolette and the employee then hurried away to the gated pool area, and Michael stayed in the parking lot.

I also spoke with another victim, an employee of the property, Damien W Burton, DOB 06/04/1978 with an IL identification, who told me the following:

While people were gathered around Michael and Ulysses, he attempted to escort Ulysses away. In doing so Michael punched him in the back of head two times.

It is important to note that at one point while conducting these interviews I heard Michael yelling and Ofc Young ordering him to stop. I made my way to Ofc Young and saw Michael actively attempting to get up and free himself from Ofc Young's grasp. I saw that Michael was beginning to kick his legs, and based on his behavior I strongly believe he was trying kick one of us. I held both his feet to the ground, preventing the use of his legs. The entire time Michael vehemently attempted to free his feet and get up from the ground. Ofc Golovanov, who was now on scene, assisted in holding Michael while I located my hobble restraint. I then used the hobble restraint to secure Michael's legs, after great difficulty due to him resisting.

We then stood Michael up and attempted to place him in the backseat of my patrol car. Michael continued to refuse our commands to get into the back seat. After great effort, we were able to seat Michael. However, he sat at the door opening making it impossible to get him in the car while in that position. Ofc Golovanov stayed with Michael, and I continued my interviews.

After concluding the interviews, I returned to Ofc Golovanov and Michael. Ofc Golovanov and I were finally able to get Michael properly seated and fully inside the car, allowing us to shut the door. This once again required great effort, from Ofc Golovanov and me, due to Michael's continued physical resistance and refusal to obey commands.

Key West Rescue arrived on scene and attended to Michael and all the victims. No victim requested transport and verbally refused further treatment. Rescue personnel informed me they were not transporting Michael and they had concluded their treatment. Michael again refused to follow commands to completely sit inside the patrol car, pointing his legs straight out, preventing me from closing the door.

After having to tell Michael several times, he finally placed his legs inside the car. I then gave each victim a Victim's Rights Brochure, with the corresponding case number. Each victim informed me they wished to pursue charges against Michael.

I photographed Michael's injuries. I also photographed the victims, of which no one had visible injuries. These photographs were later submitted to Evidence.com.

Ofc Golovanov was able to collect statements from two witnesses and one from Damien. I later submitted these statements to the Key West Records Department.

I then transported Michael to Lower Keys Medical Center, 5900 College Rd, for medical clearance. There, Sgt A Rodriguez briefly spoke with Michael. During their conversation Michael again required having to be told several

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times to follow commands.

Michael was then taken inside to medical personnel where they tended to his wounds. Ofc Golovanov later told me Michael was threatening violence against him. I also observed Michael threaten to hurt Ofc Golovanov, saying that when he got out, he was going to "fuck him up."

I then transported Michael to the Monroe County Detention Center for processing. While there, after being taken out of handcuffs by a detention deputy, Michael refused to obey commands. Michael stood from the bench where he was seated and was told by detention deputies and me to sit back down. Michael ignored our commands and instead began to walk towards us. I grabbed Michael's right arm, and a deputy grabbed his left. Michael began to attempt to pull away from us, and he was placed into handcuffs again. Detention Deputy Sergeant Sabillon then advised Michael be placed into a restraint chair. While Dep Sgt Sabillon and detention deputies attempted to place Michael into the restraint chair Michael resisted and attempted to headbutt Dep Sgt Sabillon. If not for Dep Sgt Sabillon's quick reflexes he would have been struck by Michael.

Based on the facts and evidence, I believe there is probable cause Michael Anthony Poole did knowingly and intentionally violate F.S.S. 843.01 Resisting with Violence, by purposely kicking, intending to strike an officer, while engaged in legal, lawful duties as uniformed law enforcement officer.

Based on the facts and evidence, I believe there is probable cause Michael Anthony Poole did knowingly and intentionally violate F.S.S. 843.01 Resisting with Violence, by purposely attempting to headbutt Dep Sgt Sabillon, while engaged in legal, lawful duties as uniformed law enforcement officer.

Based on the facts, the evidence, the victims' and witness' accounts, I have probable cause to believe that Michael Anthony Poole did commit a battery against Joell C Adams, in violation of FSS 784.03-1a1, by actually and intentionally punching her in the face and head against her will, intentionally causing her great pain and discomfort.

Based on the facts, the evidence, the victims' and witness' accounts, I have probable cause to believe that Michael Anthony Poole did commit a battery against Ulysses Alexander Adams, in violation of FSS 784.03-1a1, by actually and intentionally punching him in the face against him will, intentionally causing her great pain and discomfort.

Based on the facts, the evidence, the victims' and witness' accounts, I have probable cause to believe that Michael Anthony Poole did commit a battery against Charolette Ledger, in violation of FSS 784.03-1a1, by actually and intentionally punching her in head and dragging her by her hair against her will, intentionally causing her great pain and discomfort.

Based on the facts, the evidence, the victims' and witness' accounts, I have probable cause to believe that Michael Anthony Poole did commit a battery against Damien W Burton, in violation of FSS 784.03-1a1, by actually and intentionally punching him in the back of the head against his will, intentionally causing him great pain and discomfort.

Based on the facts and evidence, I believe there is probable cause that on Michael Anthony Poole did knowingly and intentionally violate F.S.S. 843.02 Resisting without Violence, by actually and intentionally attempting to pull away Ofc Young, Ofc Golovanov, and me while engaged in our legal, lawful duties as uniformed law enforcement officers.

REPORTING OFFICER NARRATIVE

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Based on the facts and evidence, I believe there is probable cause that on Michael Anthony Poole did knowingly and intentionally violate F.S.S. 843.02 Resisting without Violence, by actually and intentionally failing to follow commands to sit back down from me and detention deputies, while we were engaged in our legal, lawful duties as uniformed law enforcement officers.

Based on the facts and evidence, I believe there is probable cause that on Michael Anthony Poole committed the act of disorderly conduct, in violation of FSS 509.143, by engaging in acts of physical violence in the parking lot of the Southernmost Beach Resort, 1319 Duval St, in plain sight of hotel guests and the general public, affecting the peace and enjoyment of people in the area witnessing these actions, disrupting the otherwise joyful atmosphere, and corrupting public morals and outraging the sense of public decency.

My BWC was activated during this incident and later submitted to Evidence.com.
