Renata finally came to the door and opened it. I requested to speak with Gino. Gino then appeared in the living room. I entered and told him he was under arrest for his warrant.

Gino said no and actively physically resisted my attempts to place him under lawful arrest. Gino actively pulled away from my grasp, attempted to pull away and run. Ofc. Moore and Lt. Vazquez had to help me gain physical control over Gino as he refused to obey lawful commands to place his hands behind his back.

Upon arrival, I followed Ofc. Clark to the front of the residence. Ofc. Clark began knocking on the front door of the residence for approximately 3 minutes when the light in the room next to the front door went out. I then began to knock on the windows of the home to draw the attention of the occupants. After approximately 5 minutes of knocking, an adult female opening the front door. Ofc. Clark informed her he needed to speak with King who made himself present in the living area of the home. I then followed Ofc. Clark into the home. Ofc. Clark advised King, he had a warrant for his arrest and to place his hands behind his back. King began telling Ofc. Clark to not put his hands on him and started moving towards the hallway. Ofc. Clark took hold of King's right arm, and I took hold of King's left arm. King stiffened up his arms and began to pull away while continuing to tell us not to touch him. King continued to conceal his arms from Ofc. Clark and I. Ofc. Clark and I then took King to the ground with the assistance of Lt. Vasquez. King was placed in handcuffs and escorted from the home to Ofc. Clark's marked Key West Police patrol vehicle. King was searched and then placed in the back of Ofc. Clark's patrol vehicle.

My Axon Body Worn Camera was active for the encounter. All video was uploaded to evidence.com.

I hurried inside of the residence through now opened front door and saw Ofc. Clark, Ofc. Moore and Lt. Vazquez attempting to control Gino lying prone on the floor.

Gino was thrashing and Gino's mother was screaming at the Ofcs that Gino is just the kid.

I took hold of Gino's legs, and when Ofc. Clark handcuffed Gino, I helped the other Ofc. Clark to get Gino on his feet and escort him to Ofc. Clark's patrol vehicle.
