**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING KEY WEST CULTURAL PRESERVATION SOCIETY TO CONDUCT A SUMMER SOLSTICE CELEBRATION AT MALLORY SQUARE DOCK ON TUESDAY, JUNE 21, 2011 FROM 6:00 P.M. TO 10:00 P.M. PURSUANT TO TERMS AND CONDITIONS SET FORTH BY THE CITY MANAGER; AUTHORIZING THE SALE AND CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES WITHIN AN ENCLOSED AREA; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE**

**WHEREAS**, Key West Cultural Preservation Society wishes to conduct a Summer Solstice Celebration at Mallory Square between the hours of 6:00 p.m. and 10:00 p.m. on Tuesday, June 21, 2011; and

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the City Commission of the City of Key West, Florida;

**SECTION 1.** That the Key West Cultural Preservation Society is hereby granted permission to conduct Summer Solstice Celebration on the date and during the hours stated above; PROVIDED all trash is adequately collected and contained; guarantee indemnifying the City is executed; and provided the organizations meet the terms and conditions set forth by the City Manager.

**SECTION 2.** That pursuant to Section 18-86 of the Key West Code of Ordinances, Key West Cultural Preservation Society is hereby granted permission allowing the sale and consumption of alcoholic beverages within an enclosed area.

**SECTION 3.** That Cultural Preservation Society will adhere to the recycling plan of the City of Key West, that one (1) recycling container for every one (1) trash barrels will be used and that they will be placed side by side.

**SECTION 4.** That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signatures of the presiding officer and Clerk of the Commission.
