A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, DIRECTING THE CITY ATTORNEY AND THE CITY MANAGER TO EXPLORE STEPS NECESSARY TO OBTAIN UNALLOCATED HOUSING UNITS FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONSTRUCTING AFFORDABLE HOUSING IN THE CITY OF KEY WEST, AND TO REPORT FINDINGS TO THE CITY COMMISSION AT THE REGULAR MEETING OF JANUARY 18, 2023; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City Commission finds affordable and workforce housing development is essential to sustain and improve the economy, health, safety and welfare of citizens and visitors of Key West, Florida; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the City Manager and the City Attorney are directed to explore the steps necessary to attempt to obtain additional unallocated housing units that were previously offered to Monroe County, Islamorada, and Marathon by the State of Florida and then-Governor Scott, and report findings to the City Commission at the regular meeting scheduled for January 18th, 2023.

Section 2: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the Presiding Officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
