A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE ATTACHED "REVOCABLE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING FOR USE OF CITY PROPERTY" ("MOU") BETWEEN THE CITY OF KEY WEST AND THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE, NATIONAL OCEANIC AND ATMOSPHERIC ADMINISTRATION (NOAA) NATIONAL OCEAN SERVICE (NOS) FOR THE INSTALLATION AND MAINTENANCE OF A TIDAL STATION; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, relocation of a tide station from the East Quay is necessary, due to development of the Truman Waterfront at the former location; and

WHEREAS, relocation will provide continuity with historical, and future tidal data, providing vital information applicable to Key West Harbor; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission finds that allowing NOAA to relocate, install and maintain a tidal station within the easement granted to the City by the US Navy, would provide a benefit to residents of Key West and the United States.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the attached Revocable MOU between the City and NOAA/NOS for installation and maintenance of a tidal station, upon specific terms and conditions set forth in the Agreement, is hereby approved.

Section 2: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the Presiding Officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
