A RESOLUTION OF THE CAROLINE STREET CORRIDOR AND BAHAMA VILLAGE COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY (CRA), APPROVING A TWO-YEAR CONTRACT EXTENSION WITH RALONS SECURITY LLC; UPON CONSENT OF THE CITY ATTORNEY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, RALONS Security LLC was awarded a three-year contract agreement through Resolution #21-153; and

WHEREAS, the contract is set to expire in August 2024; and

WHEREAS, the contract allows renewal of the agreement, on the same terms and conditions, for an additional two-year period; and

WHEREAS, at its meeting of June 12, 2024, the Key West Bight Management District Board made a recommendation to the CRA to approve the two-year extension of Ralons Security LLC Port and Marine Services Contract at the Key West Bight and Key West Bight Ferry Terminal through Resolution KWBB #24-16; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CAROLINE STREET CORRIDOR AND BAHAMA VILLAGE COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the contract agreement with Ralons Security, LLC for Private Security Services at the Key West Bight and Key West Bight Ferry Terminal is extended for an additional

two-year period.

Section 2: That this contract is budgeted annually in 405 Fund.

Section 3: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the presiding officer and the Clerk of the Agency.
