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-- Derek Lang Shine J Arrest Narrative:

On 11/06/2022, at approximately 0421 hours, Ofc. M. Hansell and I, Ofc. Gruba, observed a vehicle swerving with its lights off and then pull into an employee parking only spot at 106 Simonton St.

Ofc. Hansell pulled behind the dark Volkswagon sedan, bearing Florida tag 5143AW, and I parked my patrol vehicle behind Ofc. Hansell's. The driver, later identified as Derik Shine, got out of the vehicle and immediately started to yell at Ofc. Hansell and myself. Ofc. Hansell told Shine to sit further away from the vehicle. Shine continued to argue and yell but walked further from the vehicle. Shine sat on the curb. Due to Shine's erratic behavior, Ofc. Hansell and I decided to place Shine in handcuffs. Shine immediately resisted by tensing up and attempting to pull away from us. Ofc. Hansell and I took shine to the ground, causing my prescription glasses to fall off my face and break. After multiple commands by both Ofc. Hansell and I to stop resisting, I unholstered my Taser. I attempted to drive stun Shine. In the process of trying to do so Shine grabbed the Taser with both hands, depriving me the means to protect myself with the Taser. With my left hand, I threw several downward hammer strikes to the back of his head to gain pain compliance, and have him let go of the Taser. After a few strikes, Shine let go. I put the cartridge back into the Taser and deployed the Taser probes into Shines stomach. I am unsure if both probes made positive contact on Shine, due to him still resisting. I then drive stunned Shine in the lower back and was able to gain pain compliance. Shine gave up the fight we were able to place Shine in handcuffs.

While searching Shine, incident to arrest, I found a plastic wrapper and a folded five-dollar bill in his right sock. The folded five-dollar bill had a white substance inside of it. The five-dollar bill with the white substance was handed over to Ofc. Hansell.

Key West Fire Rescue transported Shine to Lower Keys Medical Center with Ofc. Perez riding along for precautionary reasons. I drove to Lower Keys Medical Center. Shine was cleared by medical staff and the hospital. While placing Shine into my patrol vehicle, Shine bit me on the wrist but did not break skin.

Shine was transported to Monroe County Detention Center. During the transport Shine unsuccessfully tried to spit on me. Shine was handed over to detention deputies.

Derik Shine violated Florida State Statute 843.01, Resisting Officer With Violence. Shine (Defendant) knowingly and willfully [resisted] [obstructed] [opposed] myself, Ofc. Gruba, by doing violence to myself. At the time, I, Ofc. Gruba, was engaged in the [execution of legal process] [lawful execution of a legal duty]. At the time, I, Ofc. Gruba (victim) was an officer. At the time, Shine (Defendant) knew I, Ofc. Gruba (victim) was an officer.

Derik Shine violated Florida State Statute 784.07-2B, Battery on Law Enforcement Officer. Shine actually and intentionally touched or struck, myself, Ofc. Gruba, (victim) against my will. At the time of the battery, I was a sworn law enforcement officer for Key West Police Department. Shine knew I was a law enforcement officer due to my marked police car, Key West Police issued class B uniform, also Shine referring to me as "Officer Gruba." I, Ofc. Gruba (Victim) was engaged in the lawful performance of my duties when I was bitten by Shine.

Derik Shine violated Florida State Statute 843.025, Deprive Officer of Means of Protection. Shine actually and intentionally grabbed my Taser, depriving me from the use of the Taser, as a means of protection.

Reference Ofc. Hansell's arrest affidavit for the drug charges related to this incident.

My BWC was activated during this incident.

DRUG POSSESSION CONTROLLED

On 11-05-2022, I K-9 Ofc. Matthew Hansell of the Key West Police Department, had just cleared an alarm on Duval St. and turned South on Simonton St. from Front St.

I immediately observed a grey sedan approaching me from Green St. The vehicle had no lights on and was driving in what can be described as a slalom back and forth from one curb line to the other (East to West). I watched as the vehicle pulled into a parking spot to the South of the Oriole Club at 106 Simonton St.

I pulled my marked patrol unit behind the vehicle and activated my emergency lights conducting a traffic stop. At this time, I observed Derek Shine quickly jump out form the driver seat. I questioned Derek as to why he was driving the way he was, and I was met with attitude and hostility as Shine denied he was driving the way I explained and at one point denied I knew he was driving the car.

Shine was extremely nervous and kept moving away from the car. At one point yelling at me that I was not allowed to search his vehicle. I had Ofc. Gruba stay with Shine as I walked back to my patrol vehicle to conduct a driver license check and prepare citations as well as a possible K-9 sniff.

It should be noted that I am familiar with Shine and have arrested him for narcotics in the past. He is extremely uncooperative and combative with officers he encounters.

As I checked Shines information in NCIC / FCIC I watched him move further and further away form his vehicle at the same time trying to gain distance from Officer Gruba. Shine was moving toward a group of subjects standing in the sidewalk and I could tell by his actions he was attempting to try and run.

I walked back over to Shine and advised he was being detained. It was at this time that Shine became combative and violently fought with me and Ofc. Gruba. See 22-6365 for details. Shine was eventually detained and tased fighting all the way to the Lower Keys Medical Center as well as jail.

Ofc. Gruba conducted a search incident to Shines arrest and transport for Battery on law Enforcement Officer and found a cigar bag in his left sock containing a white rock-hard substance I later tested as Fentanyl (1.4 grams). Ofc. Gruba also found a \$5 bill containing additional Fentanyl (1.4 grams) in his other sock.

I conducted a K-9 sniff of the vehicle with a positive alert. See case number 22-6366 for details. I took the Fentanyl to the police station and placed it into an evidence locker to be sent to the FDLE Lab.

My BWC was used for this case.
