A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING SISTER SEASON FUND INC. THE USE OF THE SOUTHERNMOST BEACH AT 1405 DUVAL STREET FOR THE 35TH ANNUAL SURVIVORS PARTY ON MONDAY, MAY 28, 2012 FROM 4:00 P.M. TO 8:00 P.M; AUTHORIZING THE SALE AND CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES WITHIN THE BARRICADED AREA; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECITVE DATE

WHEREAS, Sister Season Fund Inc. wishes to use the Southernmost Beach Café between the hours of 4:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. on Monday, May 28, 2012 for the 35th Annual Survivors Party; and

WHEREAS, this event shall take place on the grounds of the Southernmost Beach between the hours of 4:00 p.m. and 8:00 p.m.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Commission of the City of Key West, Florida;

SECTION 1. That the Sister Season Fund Inc. is hereby granted permission for the use of the Southernmost Beach Café on the date and during the hours stated above; PROVIDED all trash is adequately collected and contained; guarantees indemnifying the City is executed; and provided the organizations meet the terms and conditions set forth by the City Manager.

SECTION 2. That pursuant to Section 18-86 of the Key West Code of Ordinances, permission is granted to allow the sale and consumption of alcoholic beverages within the enclosed area.

SECTION 3. That the Sister Season Fund Inc. will adhere to the recycling plan of the City of Key West and that one (1) recycling container for every one (1) trash barrels will be used and that they will placed side by side.

SECTION 5. That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signatures of the presiding officer and Clerk of the Commission.
