A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE USE OF TRAFFIC IMPACT FEE FUNDING FOR CONSTRUCTION OF A PARKING LOT ON CITY-OWNED PROPERTY AT THE POINCIANA HOUSING COMPLEX IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$150,000.00; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City is currently in the design phase of upgrades to Duck Avenue, including the construction of sidewalks from 14<sup>th</sup> Street to South Roosevelt Blvd., with Florida Dept. of Transportation funding, along with federal "Safe Routes to School" grant funding; and

WHEREAS, installation of the planned sidewalks will eliminate a significant number of nonconforming parking spaces for residents and businesses in the  $14^{\rm th}$  to  $17^{\rm th}$  Street blocks of Duck Avenue, without reducing the actual need for adequate parking in the area; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission finds that use of Traffic Impact Fee funding for construction of an off-street parking lot would enhance the neighborhood, and improve the safety of residents and visitors in the area;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the use of Tra	affic Impact Fee funds is hereby
authorized for construction of a par	rking lot on City-owned property
at the Poinciana Housing Complex	in an amount not to exceed
\$150,000.	
Section 2: That the proposed	parking lot must go through the
Planning process, and obtain all	required approvals and permits
before construction can commence.
