A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, APPROVING AN EXTENSION OF THE TIME LIMITATIONS OF THE SOUND CONTROL ORDINANCE PURSUANT TO SECTION 26-193(3)(B) OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES FOR THE DEMOYA GROUP AND AUTHORIZED FDOT CONTRACTORS, FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF NORTH ROOSEVELT BOULEVARD; PROVIDING CONDITIONS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, in Resolution 12-281, the Demoya Group received an extension of time limitations of the sound control ordinance from Monday through Friday for certain components of the reconstruction of North Roosevelt Boulevard; and

WHEREAS, in Resolution 13-200, the Demoya Group and authorized FDOT contractors received an additional extension of time limitations of the sound control ordinance for a portion of North Roosevelt Boulevard for additional components (sheet piling) of the reconstruction of North Roosevelt Boulevard; and

WHEREAS, in order to accelerate the construction schedule, it is necessary to grant an additional extension of the time limitations for the sound control ordinance for hours and construction work not addressed in the prior resolutions; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission finds that authorizing an extension of the time limitations, pursuant to section 26-193(3)(B) of the code of ordinances, would help to expedite this major construction project, and thereby benefit residents and visitors to the City of Key West.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That an extension of the time limitations to the Sound Control Ordinance, Section 26-193, is hereby granted to Demoya Group and authorized FDOT contractors, to allow construction on the North Roosevelt Boulevard project on a 24-hour-per day schedule, Monday through Sunday along the entire length of the North Roosevelt Boulevard construction project.

Section 2: That this exemption is conditioned upon the Demoya Group, or other authorized FDOT contractors, providing written notice of after-hours construction at least 24 hours in advance to businesses within 100 feet of the operation, and providing notice two weeks prior to after-hours construction to residences within 100 feet of the operation, until the project is complete.

Section 3: That the work to be conducted primarily includes, but is not limited to, pipe installation, paving operations, signal/lighting work and grading/earthwork, including the use of delivery and loading equipment as necessary. The entire project may last up to two years.

Section 4: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the presiding officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
