Dear Ms. Fernandez:

Thank you for your letter of March 29th. The Department accepts this letter as confirmation the fence between the subject facility and the adjacent school has been repaired. Thus, this letter completes the Certification of Construction Completion submitted March 10, 1995 along with the other documents required for official closure procedures of the landfill.

Your letter also clarified that the landfill last received waste before January 6, 1993, however, it was receiving incinerator ash as an approved cover material. Based on this clarification the post closure long-term care period is determined to be twenty (20) years from the date of this letter, April 24, 1996 which is to be construed as the official date of closing of the Stock Island Landfill.


