The Code Officer was David Wilson. The Respondent did not attend. Officer Wilson read his timeline. Officer Wilson stated that the subject business is in compliance now, but the City is requesting a finding of the violation since this is a recurring violation with \$250.00 administrative cost. The Special Magistrate thought that there was substantial evidence for a finding of the violation and imposed \$250.00 administrative cost.

The Code Officer was Jim Young who was not present. Attorney Van Fischer was present on behalf of the Complainant Danny Hughes. The Respondent Zach Bair was present. Assistant City Attorney Ryan Waterhouse was present on behalf of the City. Assistant City Attorney Ryan Waterhouse objected to the fact that the Complainant Danny Hughes being represented by Attorney Van Fischer due to the complainant for the City not having party status, and stated that Mr.Fischer can not step into his clients shoes, and was not a first hand witness to the event. The Special Magistrate gave an update as to where this case left off at from the last hearing where the conditional use for the subject business was brought up, and the City did not amend the notice to charge the business with possibly violating the conditional use. The Special Magistrate also stated that he can not find any justification that he can make a ruling on a case that is brought forth by the Complainant. The Special Magistrate
