A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF A HUBER WAP SCREENING WASH PRESS FROM HUBER TECHNOLOGY, INC. ON A BRAND NAME, SOLE SOURCE, AND IN THE BEST INTERESTS OF THE CITY, PURSUANT TO SECTION 2-844, 2-797(1) AND 2-797(4)(b) OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, IN A TOTAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$68,750.00; AUTHORIZING NECESSARY BUDGET TRANSFERS OR ADJUSTMENTS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, Section 2-796 of the Code of Ordinances requires competitive bidding for purchases or services in excess of \$50,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the purchase of a Huber WAP Screening Wash Press pursuant to the brand name specifications provisions of Key West Code of Ordinances section 2-844 is permitted; and

WHEREAS, City staff determined that Huber equipment, available exclusively through Huber Technology, Inc., is cost-effective and the best choice for the City's purposes; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the purchase of one Huber WAP Screening Wash from Huber Technology, Inc. is hereby approved on a brand name basis, pursuant to Code of Ordinances section 2-844, sole source basis, pursuant to Code of Ordinances Section 2-797(1), and Section 2-797(4)(b), best interests of the City, in an amount not to exceed \$68,750.00.

Section 2: That this purchase is funded in budget account Sewer/WWTP/infrastructure account 401-3504-535-6300. A budget adjustment to reallocate \$18,750.00 within the sewer plant infrastructure account from the fuel tank removal project to the screening wash purchase and installation is hereby authorized.

Section 3: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the Presiding Officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
