Original Narrative By Michal Brablc, 08/19/25 18:21

On Tuesday, August 19, 2025, at approximately 1016 hours, I (Officer Michal Brablc) was dispatched to 512 Greene St, Tattoos and Scars bar, in reference a male subject trespassing on property and being violent.

On my way to the above location, I called the (RP) Casey Vinall. Vinall stated a black male subject, dressed all in black (black shoes, black jeans, black t-shirt and black leather vest) entered the back parking lot of the establishment. It should be noted, the subject stepped over a chain to enter the property. Vinall confronted the subject and told him the business was closed and asked him to leave. The subject became belligerent and started yelling at Vinall. Vinall told the subject he was trespassing and that the "no trespassing" were posted. The subject said; "I don't give a fuck" and attempted to rip the signs of the wall. The subject bent one of the signs and damaged one of the hooks holding the chain up. Vinall said the approximate damage was valued at \$20.00.

The incident was captured on the establishment's security camera.

Vinall told me, he did not wish to press charges, but wished for the subject to be issued a trespass warning. I located the subject at the 400-block of Duval St. I approached the subject and attempted to speak with him. The subject had a loud speaker in his pocket and refused to turn it down. The subject did not want to speak with me and refused to identify himself. Since Vinall said he did not want to press charges, I did not have the grounds to detain him. I issued him a verbal warning and advised him to not go back to Tattoos and Scars.

I called Vinall back and notified him of the outcome.

At approximately 1215 hours, Vinall called back and advised the subject has returned to the property. Officer M. Johnson and I responded to the location. Officer Johnson spoke with Vinall and I attempted to locate the subject. Vinall advised, he now wished to press criminal mischief and trespassing charges against the subject. Officer Johnson and I looked for the subject for approximately 45 minutes to no avail.

At 1506 hours, Vinall called my cellphone and advised, the subject just walked by the bar and was last seen walking towards Sloppy Joes. I responded to the location and began looking for the subject. Officer Johnson and Officer Stevens advised they were both en route to assist.

I located the subject at Simonton Beach. I notified KWPd dispatch that I was out with him and proceeded to approach him. The subject was then shirtless, and it appeared he had just gotten out of water. All of his belonging were on the ground next to him. Once I approached the subject, I informed him that he had violated the warning I personally issued to him earlier by going back to the bar. I told the subject he was under arrest for criminal mischief and trespassing.

Once I grabbed the subjects right wrist he tensed up, I told him to not resist but it only made him resist more. The subject attempted to pull away from several times. I span him around by his arm and pulled him to the ground. Once on the ground, the subject ceased to resist and I placed him in handcuffs. Officer Johnson and Officer Stevens arrived on the scene shortly after. Officer Johnson assisted me with getting the subject up. I searched the subject and placed him in the back seat of my patrol vehicle.

I notified Sergeant Carter Sims of the incident, and he responded to the scene.

The subject provided a name Nick Lops, DOB 06/11/1996 and advised he was born in Miami-Dade County. I was not able to locate his information in F/NCIC. Lops also stated, he never had a State ID. KWPd dispatch later located the subjects information. His name was Lops Frantzy Nicolas of Key West, DOB 6/11/1993.

Based on his actions and evidence provided I believed there was probable cause for Nicolas' arrest for violation of the following:

- 843.02, Fla. Stat. RESISTING OFFICER WITHOUT VIOLENCE

1. Nicolas resisted Officer Brabc. (1 count for active resistance, 1 count for providing false identification and date of birth)
2. At the time, Officer Brabc was engaged in the lawful execution of a legal duty.
3. At the time, Officer Brabc was a Police officer.
4. At the time, Nicolas knew Officer Brabc was an officer.

- 806.13(1), Fla. Stat. CRIMINAL MISCHIEF

1. Nicolas damaged real property.
2. The property injured or damaged belonged to Tattoos and Scars.
3. The injury or damage was done willfully and maliciously.
4. The damage was estimated to be approximately \$20.

- 810.09(1)(a)1, Fla. Stat. TRESPASS—ON PROPERTY OTHER THAN A STRUCTURE OR CONVEYANCE

1. Nicolas willfully entered upon or remained in property other than a structure or conveyance.
2. The property was Tattoos and Scars.
3. Notice not to enter upon or remain in that property had been given by actual communication to the defendant and posting of the property.

I transported Nicolas to the Monroe County Detention Center without incident.

During the search of Nicolas' belonging at the MCDL, four, black, small bags were found. The black bags contained a white powdery substance. I tested the substance, and it tested positive for methamphetamine. Officer Bernatova processed the substance into KCPD evidence. The substance weighed 26.6 gram. The bags were found inside of Nicolas' right inner pocket of the leather vest.

I found probable cause for an additional charge against Nicolas:

- 893.135(1)(f)(1), Fla. Stat. TRAFFICKING IN METHAMPHETAMINE

1. Nicolas knowingly possessed a substance.
2. The substance was methamphetamine
3. The methamphetamine weighed 26.6 Gram.

My AXON body worn camera as well as my AXON Fleet camera were activated.

Officer Stevens collected video surveillance from Tattoos and Scars and uploaded it to Evidence.com

On August 19, 2025, Ofc Brabc asked me to collect video evidence from Tattoos and Scars, 512 Greene St, Key West, Florida, in reference to a this investigation. Upon arrival, I met with the manager, Casey VINALL, who transferred video evidence to a USB drive, which I have since uploaded to the evidence server.

Supplemental Narrative By Andrea Bernatova, 08/19/25 17:32

On August 19, 2025, at approximately 1650 hours, I, Ofc. Bernatova, responded to Monroe County Detention Center (5501 College Road) to assist Ofc. Brabc.

Ofc. Brabc told me he seized small balloons containing white powdery substance off his arrestee's person and he needed the test kit to field test the substance.

I had the multi-drug test available and together we tested the substance in MCDC (recorder on Ofc. Brable's BWC. The substance tested positive for Methamphetamine.

I transported the balloons to the KWPD Station, weighted them (combined net weight of 26.6 Grams), packaged the substance and submitted it to KWPD Evidence/Property Section under the case number, to be send to FDLE lab for testing.
