1009 CATHERINE STREET EASEMENT

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, APPROVING AN EASEMENT OF APPROXIMATELY 441 SQUARE FEET TO ADDRESS THE ENCROACHMENT OF AN EXISTING KNEE WALL AND CHAIN LINK FENCE ENCLOSING PARTS OF A FRONT PORCH, WALKWAY AND CARPORT RELATED TO A NON-CONTRIBUTING HISTORIC STRUCTURE LOCATED ON THE NORTHEAST SIDE OF CATHERINE STREET AT 1009 CATHERINE STREET, KEY WEST, FLORIDA (RE#00031880-000000); PROVIDING FEES AND CONDITIONS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That an easement of approximately 441 square feet for the real property described in the attached specific purpose survey prepared by J. Lynn O'Flynn, Inc. dated November 10, 2010 is granted subject to the execution of the attached easement agreement, incorporating the minimum conditions described in section 2 below.

Section 2: That the following conditions shall apply to the grant of easement: (1) The easement shall terminate upon the replacement of the structure and there shall be no expansion or further encroachments in the easement area. (2) That the City may unilaterally terminate the easement upon a finding of public purpose by vote of the Key West City Commission. (3) That the owner shall pay the yearly fee specified in Code of Ordinances section 2-938, as may be amended from time to time. (4) That the owner shall irrevocably appoint the City Manager as its agent to permit the removal of the encroachment(s) if the yearly fee required by the Code of Ordinances is not paid. (5) That the easement shall terminate upon the failure of the property owner to maintain liability insurance in a minimum amount of one hundred thousand dollars per person and two hundred thousand per incident, or such other amount as may legislatively be determined to be the maximum extent of sovereign immunity waiver, naming the City as an additional insured for that portion of real property which is the subject of this easement. Pursuant to Florida Statute 768.28, this amount shall increase to two hundred thousand dollars per person and three hundred thousand dollars per incident beginning October 11, 2011. (6) That the City reserves the right to construct surface improvements within the easement area.

Section 3: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the

signature of the presiding officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
