This Indenture, made this the 12th day of July, A.D. 1919, between the E.H. Gato Cigar Company, a corporation existing under the laws of the State of West Virginia of the first part, and THE CITY OF MRY WEST, a municipal corporation existing under the laws of the State of Florida, of the second part-

Witnesseth, That the said party of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of SILVY THOUSAND DILARS, to it in hall paid by the party of the saced part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained and sold to the said party of the second part, its successors and assigns forever, the following described land, situate, lying and being in the County of Monros and State of Florida, to-wit:

On the Island of Key West and known on W.A. Whitshead's may of said Island delineated in Paby. A.D. 1829 , as Part of the Northwest One third of Tract Pourteen (14), being all the land owned by grantor contained within the boundaries of Division, Georgia and Virginia Streets, and the North Beach, together with all the riparian rights thereto, to which grantor may be entitled under the laws of the State of Florida. It being agreed and understood that grantor does not comrey those lots within said boundaries heretofore purchased by Eleanor Bellings and Richard M. Bulth, towfit formunating at the corner of Georgia and Division Directs and tune thouse on the line of Division Direct in a Sign, by direction One hundred and forty five feet and three inhos; thenfo at right angle in a S.E. 19 direction Righty one feet and Rhs inches; thence at right angles in a S.W. ly direction One hundred and forty five feet and three inches; thence at right angles along Georgia Street in a N.W.'ly direction Eighty one feet and Size inches to

And the said party of the first part does hereby fully warrant the title to said land, and will defend the same against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever.

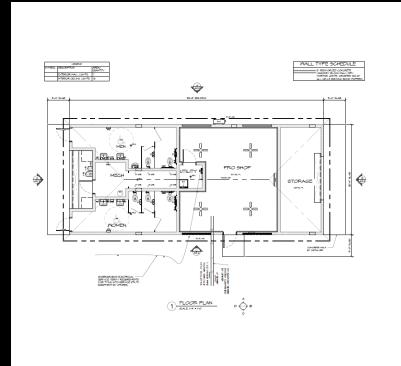

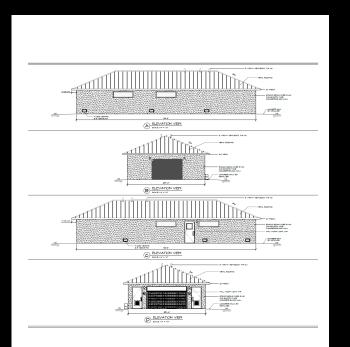

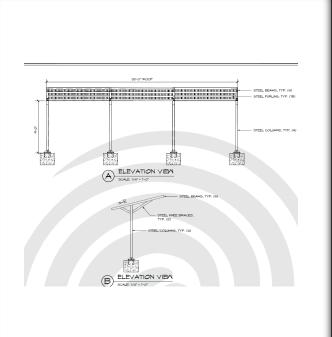






BATHROOM-PRO SHOP-MAINTENANCE BUILDING LAYOUT

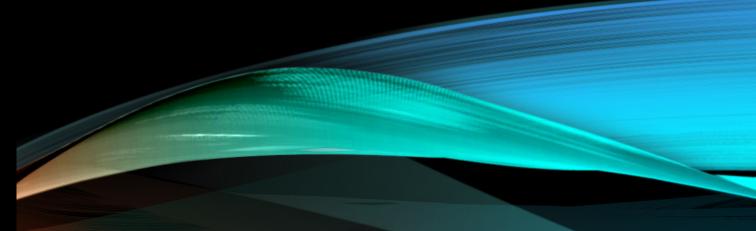
